1785 (Mar.) showing "SHIP LRE/BRISTOL, 123" ** to ** (Robertson S.4), a scarce h.s., bishopmark across flap. (See Photo Plate V)
1785 (Apr.) showing "LIVER/POOL" **; 1787 with the circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** across the flap; 1788 with "LIVERPOOL/SHIP LRE" ** (Robertson S.2) and 1794 with "LIVERPOOL/SHIP" ** to ** (S.1)

1785 (June) showing a circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** on the flap and the scarce "EXETER/SHIP LRE" * to ** on the front (Robertson S.1). (See Photo Plate V)

1785 (July) and 1786, each showing a straight line "GREENOCK" and a 7 mm. "SHIP" struck in the same ink. * to **, both with bishopmarks; also 1789 with "PT GLASGO/SHIP LRE" (Robertson S.1)

1786 showing "PORTSMOUTH/SHIP. LRE" ** to ** (Robertson S.1); 1789 with "COWES / SHIP LRES" ** (S.1); 1789 with "SHIP-LRE" ** and 1790 with "BRISTOL/SHIP. LRE", mostly ** (S.1)

1787 showing "LONDON/SHIP-LRE" ** (Robertson S.6) and a circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** on the flap. (See Photo Plate V)

1788 showing a partly overstamped circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** and "DOVER/SHIP-LRE", mostly ** to ** (Robertson S.3). (See Photo Plate V)

1789 (Feb.) showing the rare "BEAUMARIS/SHIP LRE" **, just across a filing fold (Robertson S.1). (See Photo Plate V)

1789 (Apr.) showing "DEAL/SHIP-LRE" ** to ** (Robertson S.4) and a circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** on flap. (See Photo Plate V)

1789 (May) showing a partly overstamped circular framed "GRENADA" and crown ** and "RAMSGATE/SHIP-LRE" ** (Robertson S.1). (See Photo Plate V)


