The Portuguese explorer Vasco da Gama saw the coast of Natal on Christmas Day 1497. Natal is the Portuguese word for Christmas which gave rise to the European name for the region.

The first settlers, mostly British, established Port Natal, as a trading post.

The territory was once part of a short-lived Boer republic between 1839 and 1843 until its annexation by Britain.

The colony acquired Zululand (the area north of the Tugela River) after the Zulu War of 1879.




