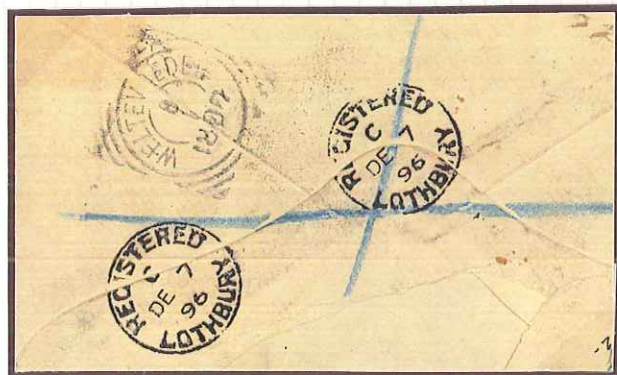




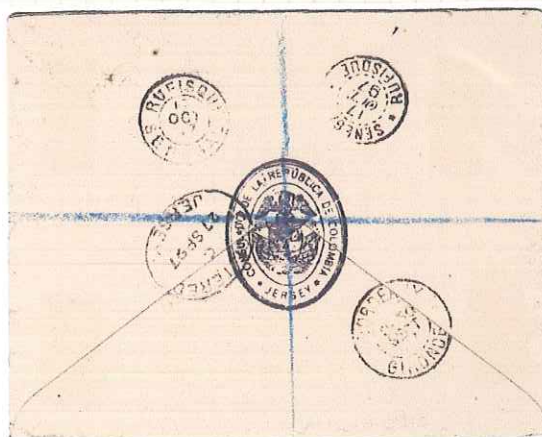
Very late usage of Jubilee issue

1903 usage of the KEV11 3d Brown Registered envelope to "Angola via Lisbon" uprated with Jubilee 2d strip of three +KEV11 1/2d tied by Strand cds. Backstamped with Lisbon receiving cancel.

Rare destination for letters from Great Britain to Manado,
 (in the far NE of the straggling islands of Indonesia)
 via Brindisi to Vetteveder (suburb of Batavia where letters to the 'Out Islands' were sorted)
 Paid 4½d being 2½d postage + 2d registration
 Sent from Lothbury 7th December 1896 arr, Vetteveder 8th January 1897



Unusual destination for letter from the Consul of the Republic of Colombia, Jersey Channel Islands,
via London and Bordeaux
(when passing into French territory)
and onward to Rufisque (near Dakar) in Senegal West Africa.
Sent 27th September 1897, arriving 17th October.





Overpaid cover to Frankfurt with London hooded cancels dated 25 July 1893 featuring the Hoster machine cancel alongside.

On reverse, receiving mark and interesting advertisement for De Keyser's Royal Hotel stating
"Electric Light in every Room"
