
## PENNY RED COVER - OVERSEAS MAIL 1864

SG43 PI79 double rate entire to Paris rated 8d with a London double ring c.d.s. for 'SP/30/Paid' in red. An additional 1d late fee is pre-paid by the 1d rose-red. The 1d stamp cancelled by a number '7' numeral and not the '50' or '51' usually associated with the Late Fee Office.

A Calais c.d.s., oval 'PD' and straight line 'Franco' complete this unusual cover. Exhibition potential.



## U.S.A. TO G.B. 1855

An unusual cover from U.S.A, to Manchester then re-addressed to Edinburgh when 1855 1d Red Stars P.14 was applied.

American handstamps 'Paid', '24', dumb circular grid marking and 'NH' (New

Hampshire) c.d.s. for 'Oct 9', all in blue.
The adhesive 1d tied by Manchester duplex '498' dd 'Oc/22/1855' in black with c.d.s. 'American/Paid/Liverpool' for the same date, both in red.

On reverse Boston datestamp '10 Oct BR PKT', Manchester arrival (Oct 22) and, presumably, Edinburgh arrival datestamp for 'Oct/23/1855'. A scarce and interesting cover.



## **PENNY RED COVER 1859**

SG40 1d rose-red (K-D) posted London to Brighton showing fine strike of the Time Posted Clock.



## **PENNY RED COVER 1857**

SG40 (F-A) with very good York Spoon cancellation dd 'OC/20/1857'. Malton receiving chop for the following day on reverse. Wax seal.
