19 MAR 1851 Entire letter sent from LONDON to ALEXANDRIA with m/s "French Steamer via Marseilles". The letter bearing oval in blue FORWARDING AGENTS in ALEXANDRIA "PASTRE FRERES", and tied by L.S. CROSS dated 19/3/1851. ALEXANDRIA arrival at British post office c.d.s. dated 30 MAR 1851. Transit time 12 days.



21 MAR 1852 Entire letter sent from ALEXANDRIA arrival MARSEILLE (12) on 28 MAR 1852 by S.S. "LOUQSOR" bearing boxed "PAQUEBOTS DE LA MEDITERRANEE" in red. The letter bearing oval in blue FORWARDING AGENTS in ALEXANDRIA "TURIN FRERES", and tied by ALEXANDRIA dated 24/3/1851. ALEXANDRIA arrival at British post office c.d.s. dated 30 MAR 1851. Transit time 10 days.

26 JUL 1855 Entire letter sent from ALEXANDRIA arrival MARSEILLE on 3 AUG 1855 by S.S. "TAMISE" bearing boxed "PAQUEBOTS DE LA MEDITERRANEE" in red. The letter bearing oval in green FORWARDING AGENTS in ALEXANDRIA "NAZZIO & Co." and tied by ALEXANDRIA c.d.s. dated 24/31851. Transit time 9 days.



13 JUL 1857 Entire letter sent from ALEXANDRIA arrival LIVORNO on 22 JUN 1857 by S.S. "HYDASPE" departed on 13/6 and arrived on 21/6 on 22 JUN 1857. The letter bearing oval "FORWARDED BY / MESSERS RS / BRIGGS & Co", with French post office in ALEXANDRIA c.d.s. dated 13/6 /57, and m/s "PAR LE BATEAU DES MESSAGERIES". Transit time 10 days. Paid 10c. sea rate + 9c. French rate total 19c.7.5gr, covering the postal rate of the destination.

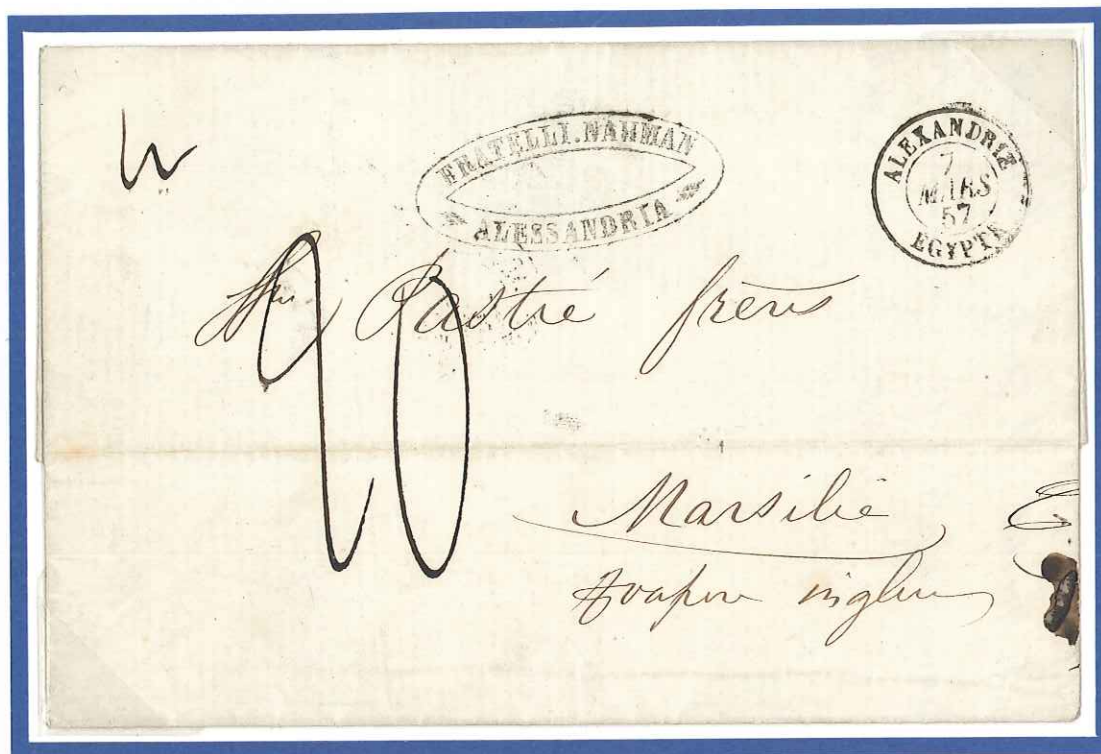

The letter bearing oval in black FORWARDING AGENTS in ALEXANDRIA "FRATELLI NAHMAN" with French post office in ALEXANDRIA c.d.s. dated 7/3 /57. "Transit time 9 ays.
Paid 20c. 2nd weight stage/7.5 gr, covering the postal rate of the destination.



20 FEB 1857 Entire letter sent from ALEXANDRIA arrival MARSEILLIE on 27 FEB 1857. The letter bearing oval "TURIN FRERES " FORWARDING" in green at ALEXANDRIA . With "PAQ .ANG. MARSEILLIE " c.d.s. dated 27/2 /57.
"Transit time 8 ays.
Paid 10c. /7.5 gr, covering the postal rate of the destination.

Paid 50c.7.5gr, covering the postal rate of the destination.



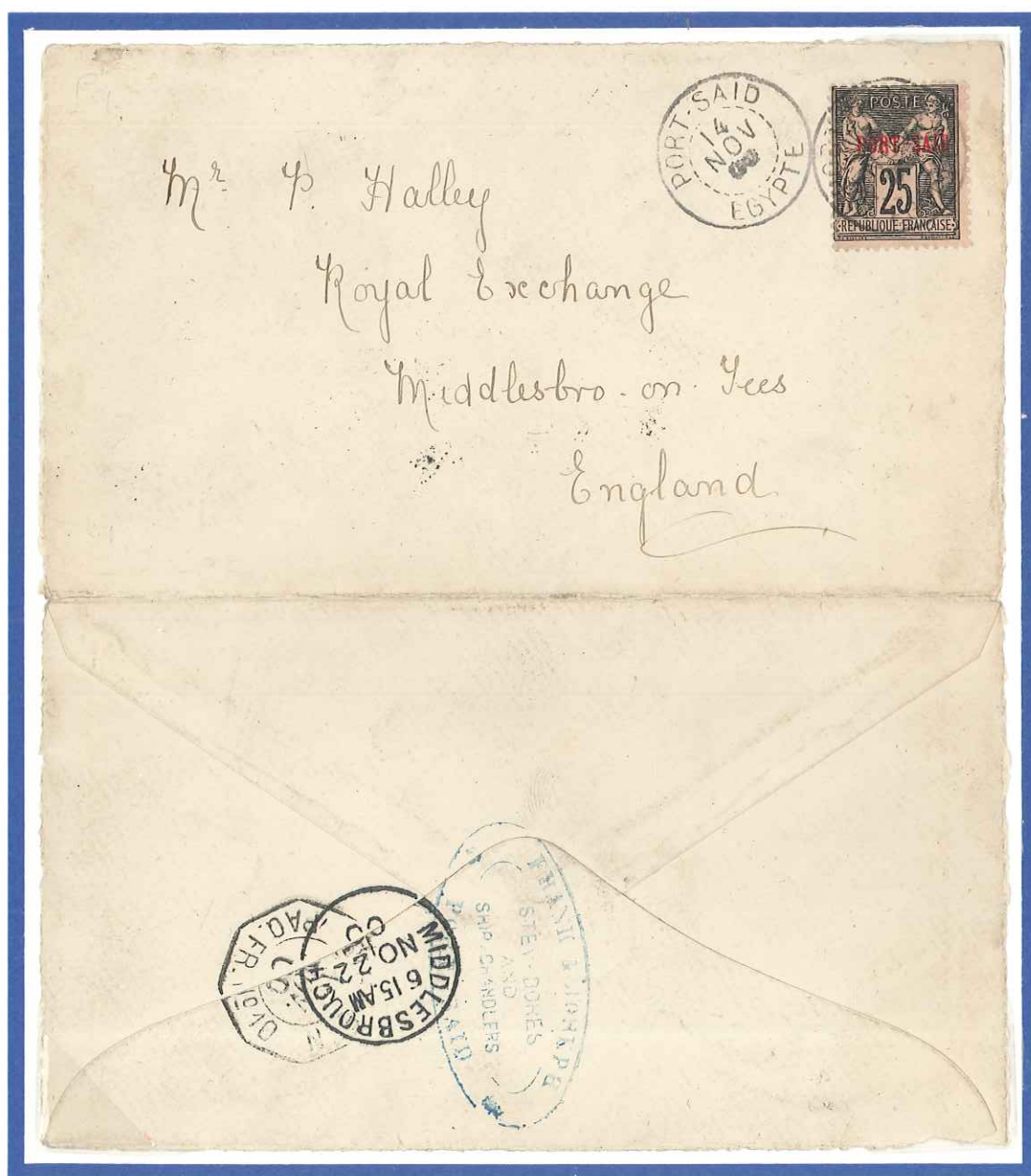
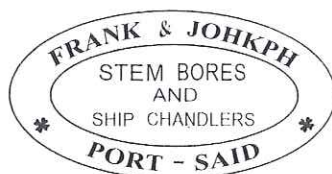
29 MAY 1867 Entire letter sent from ALEXANDRIA arrival BORDEAUX on 5 JUN 1867 by S.S. "SAID". The letter bearing oval in blue FORWARDING AGENTS in ALEXANDRIA "GSELL & BIRCHER", and tied by ALEXANDRIA Frinsh post office c.d.s. dated 29/5/67. Transit time 8 days.
Paid 40c.10gr, covering the postal rate of the destination.

14 NO 1900 envelope sent from PORT SAID to MIDDLESBROUGH on 22 NO arrival by S.S. "LAOS" Which leave YOKOHAMA on 10 OC 1900 and arrival MARSEILLE on 18 NO. With "LIGNE N PAQ FR No 10" "LIGNE N PAQ FR No 10" octagonal dated 15 NO 1900. Cancelled at FRENCH postal agency "FRANK & JOHKPH /STEM BORES -AND- SHIP CHANDLERS/ PORT-SAID" at PORT SAID on 14 NO 1900. Transit time 9 days.

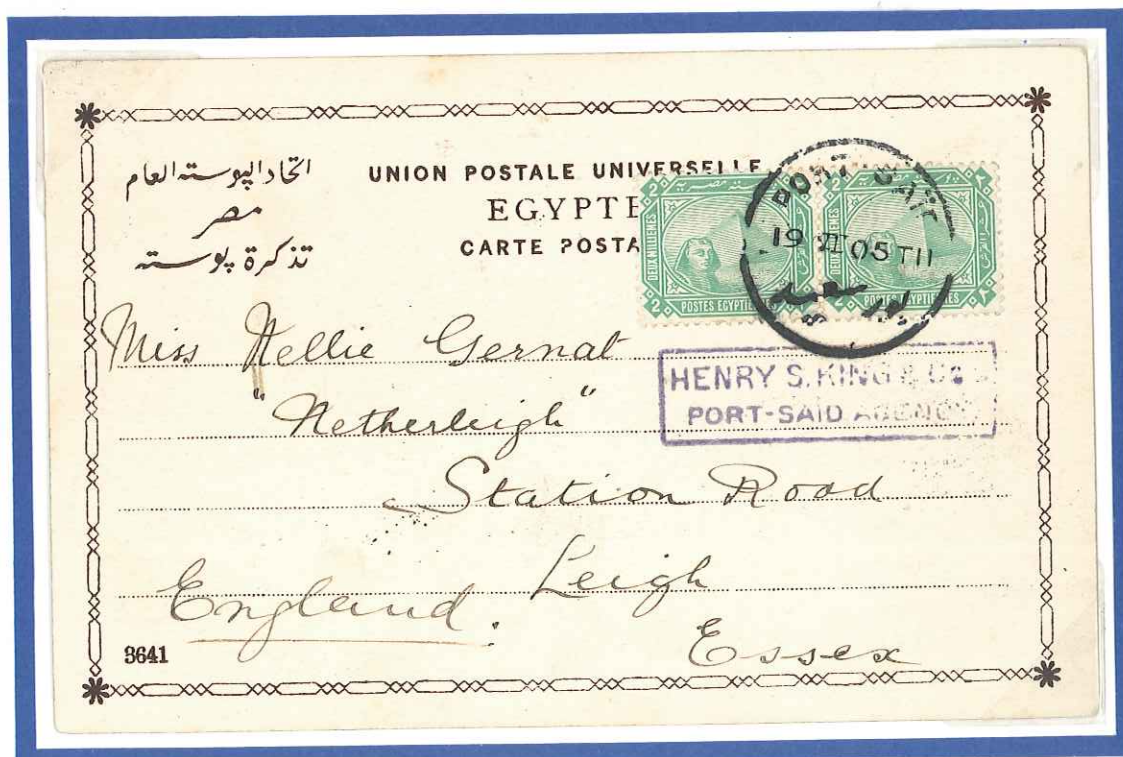

19 FEB 1905 Postcard sent from PORT-SAID to ENGLAND by S.S. "CALEDONIA" with boxed "HENRY S. KING & Co'S/PORT-SAID AGENCY" in blue. With PORT-SAID c.d.s. dated 19-2-1905. Paid 4 Mills./ Postcard., Covering the postal rate of the destination.
