
























1891-1916 POST OFFICES IN CHINA

Various cancellations of KALGAN (later CHANGKIAKOW).

- A. Subtype 3A. 7k 1883-88 issue tied to piece by FORGERY dated 1 IV 1891.
- B. Type 5 (= Type 3 of T&S). 7k 1902-05 issue tied to piece dated 1904 and 'Kitai' issues 1r (1904) dated 3 XI 1904 & 3r50k (1907) dated 3 IIII 1907.
- C. Type 6 (= Type 5 of T&S). Romanov values on two pieces dated 7 7 16 and 9 7 16 respectively. Also 3r50k 1889-92 issue dated 9 2 09.

1880-1893 POST OFFICES IN CHINA

KALGAN Type 3 Subtype A

- A. Original drawing of T&S ("Russia used Abroad", 1959, p.347, fig. 477) with date 6 X 1880, incorrectly showing year numerals of equal size in left and right side of oval.
- B. Forgery (facsimile) dated 1 IV 1891, based on incorrect T&S fig. 477
- C. 1k and two 3k tied to piece by Kalgan Subtype 3A dated 13 Vii 1893 showing small numerals in right side of year as normal.
- D. 2k 1879 issue with incomplete strike of Kalgan Subtype 3A dated 5 III 188in red (only known Kalgan cancellation in this colour). Missing part of postmark shown by broken lines.
