

These stamps were issued on January 27, 1975 to commemorate the 2nd anniversary of the Paris Agreement on Viet-Nam. This agreement was negotiated between Henry Kessinger of the United States and Le Duc Tho of North Viet-Nam. It provided for the United States withdrawing its troops in March of 1973 and resulted in the Viet Minh winning control of South Viet-Nam in April of 1975.

The green stamp depicts U.S., South Viet-Nam, North Viet-Nam and the Revolutionary Provisional Government signing the cease fire agreement in Paris on January 27, 1973. The blue stamp depicts the International Conference in session. The stamps were printed in panes of 100.

These five stamps were issued on February 3, 1975 to commemorate the 45th anniversary of the formation of the Indochinese Communist Party which was formed in 1930 in Hong Kong by Ho Chi Minh. The four 12 xu stamps depict some of the founders of the Party. These stamps are almost identical to the ones issued in 1968 to commemorate the Party's 40th anniversary. The 60 xu value depicts Ho Chi Minh as he looked in 1924.

These eight stamps depicting medicinal plants of Viet-Nam were issued on February 8, 1975. They were printed in panes of 50. Like most Vietnamese topical stamps, these exist imperforate.

This stamp was issued on April 4, 1975 to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the formation of the Hungarian Republic in 1945. The stamp depicts Hungary's coat of arms and was designed by H. Khan. The Michel Catalog inconvently 11514 the date of 15500 as August 30, 1975.

These stamps were issued on May 19, 1975 to commemorate the 85th anniversary of Ho-Chi-Minh's birth. He was born on May 19, 1980. Stamps with an identical design (but a different inscription) were issued on October 6, 1975 by the Revolutionary Provisory Government of South Viet-Nam.

These four stamps were issued in 1975, perhaps September 15th, to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the People's Republic of Poland. In July, 1944, the Soviet government sponsored the formation of a Polish Committee of National Liberation, an organization largely dominated by communists. This Committee established headquarters at Lublin, Poland and proclaimed itself the provisional government of Poland on December 31, 1944.

The stamps depict the Nike Monument, and they were designed by T. Luong.

These three stamps were issued on September 2, 1975 to commemorate the 30th Anniversary of the Democratic Republic of Viet-Nam. The Declaration of Independence was proclaimed by Ho Chi Minh in Ba Dinh Square in Hanoi on September 2, 1945.

The stamp depicting Ho Chi Minh reading the Declaration of Independence was designed by Huy Khanh. The stamps depicting the Vietnamese emblem and the Vietnamese flag were designed by <u>Viet Tuan</u>. They were all printed in pages of 100.

This is one of a number of stamps issued on September 15, 1975 to commemorate the anniversaries of various communist and/or socialist governments. This one commemorates the 25th anniversary of the German Democratic Republic which was established on October 7, 1945, the date inscribed on the stamp. It was formed from the part of Germany given to the Russians to administer after World War II.

This stamp was designed by Viet Tuan and depicts the flags of Viet-Nam and the German Democratic Republic. The stamp was printed in panes of 100.

October 1, 1949, the date inscribed on the stamp, is the date the Republic was established.

This one commemorates the 20th anniversary of Algeria's war for independence. On November 1, 1954, the date inscribed on the stamp, a nationalist uprising in a mountainous area of East Algeria brought French troops into the area to restore order. Algeria finally achieved its independence in 1962.

These stamps were issued on June 24, 1976 to call attention to the first session of the Unified National Assembly. They depict a map of Viet-Nam and each bears a different slogan of re-unification.

A similar set of stamp with a different inscription was issued by the Revolutionary Provisory Government of South Viet-Nam. This was the last set of stamps issued by North Viet-Nam. After these two, all stamps were issued for the unified Republic of Viet-Nam.

This is the first stamp issued by Viet-Nam since the reunification. It was issued on June 24, 1976. This stamp received some publicity because the map pointedly included the Paracel and Spratly Islands, all also claimed by Peking. According to Newsweek, "Taiwan and the Philippines also have laid claim to the Spratlys and, like Vietnam, have armed forces stationed there. Hanoi has broadcast propaganda claiming the islands, but this is the first time it has, in effect, put the claim in writing, and the protests are expected to escalate accordingly."
