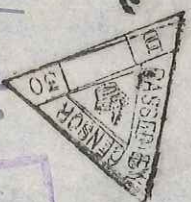

THE FPO SYSTEM OF THE MESOPOTAMIAN EXPEDITIONARY FORCE CLOSED DOWN ON 1ST MAY 1919 WITH THE RESTORATION OF CIVIL POSTAL FACILITIES IN IRAQ. OTHER FPOS OPENED ALMOST IMMEDIATELY WITH THE OUTBREAK OF TROUBLES.

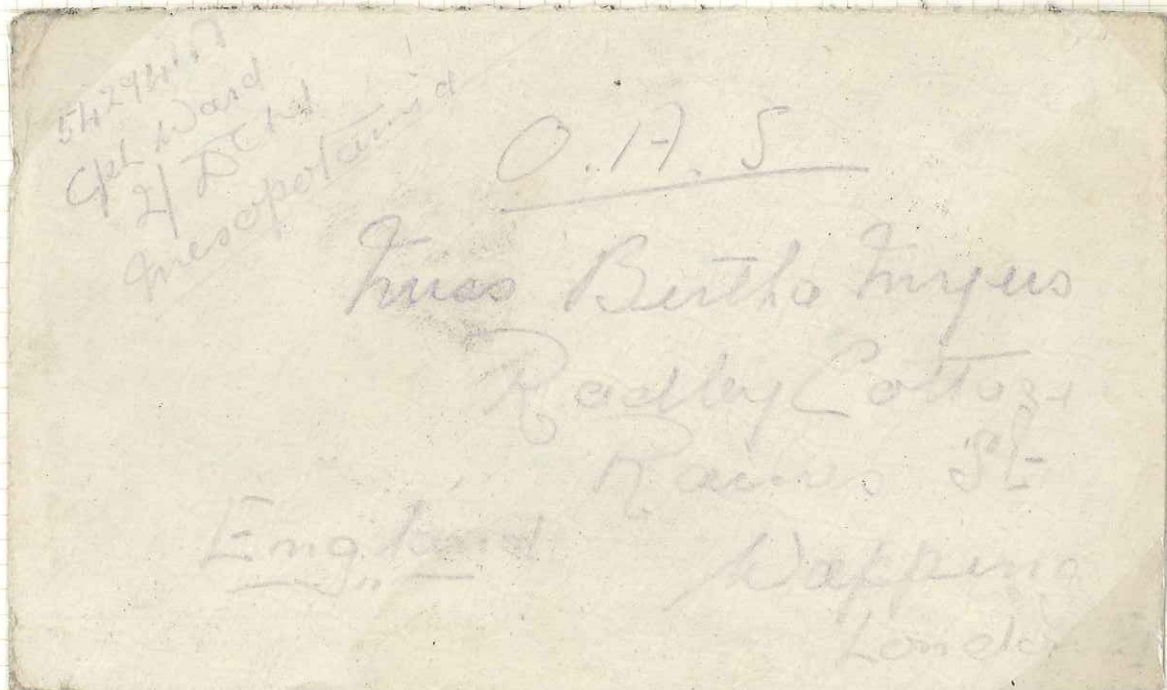
KURDISTAN 1919
