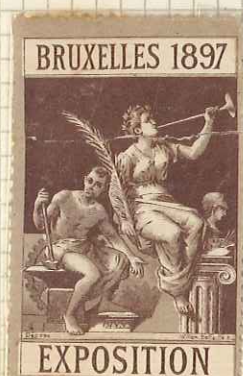


Card picturing Colonial Exhibit Building



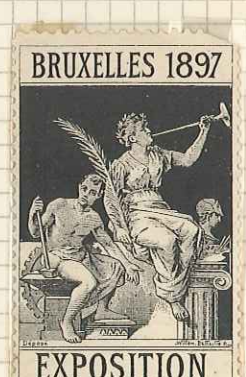

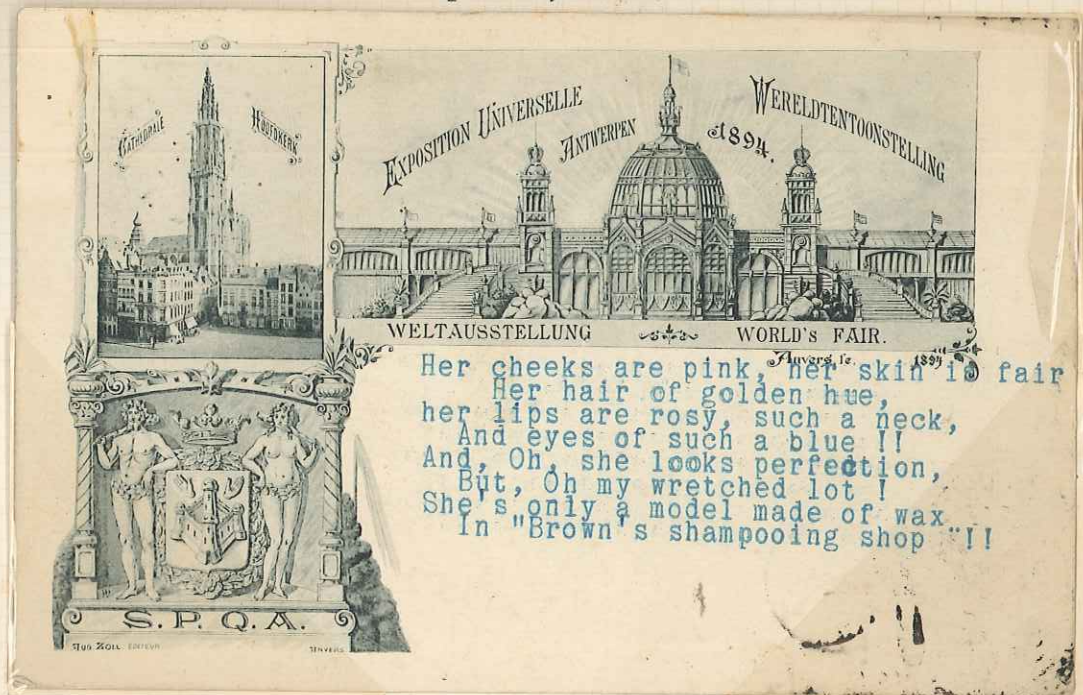

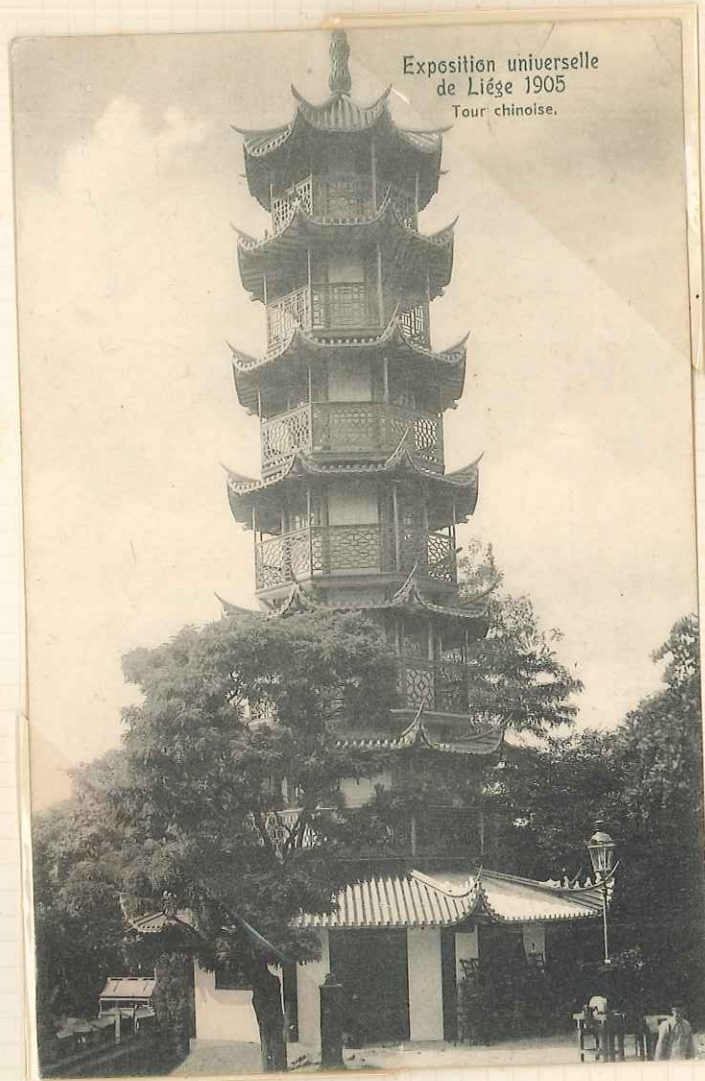

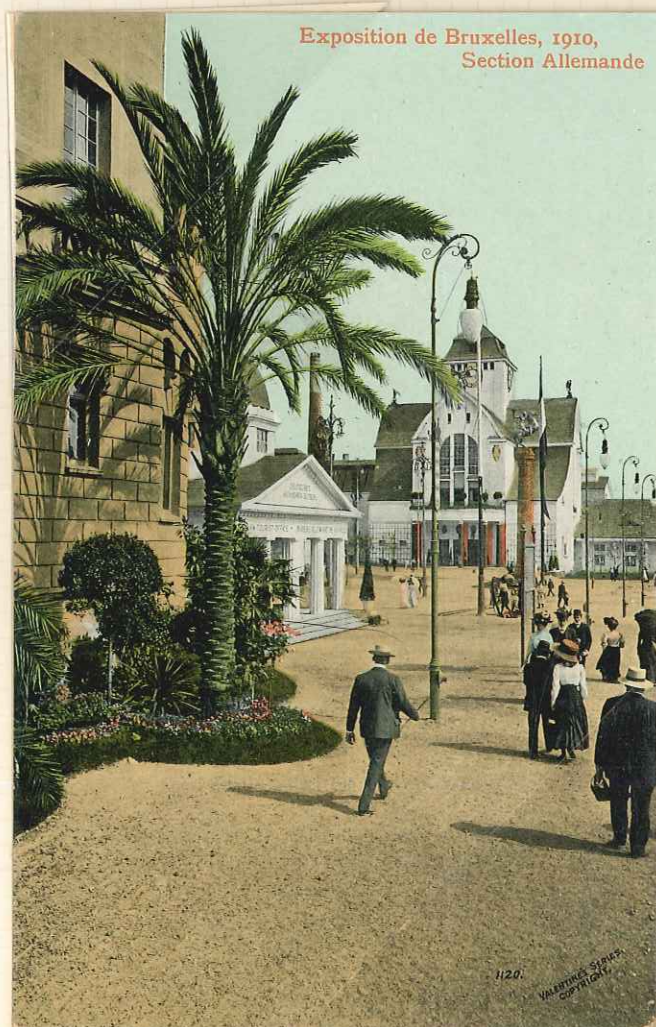

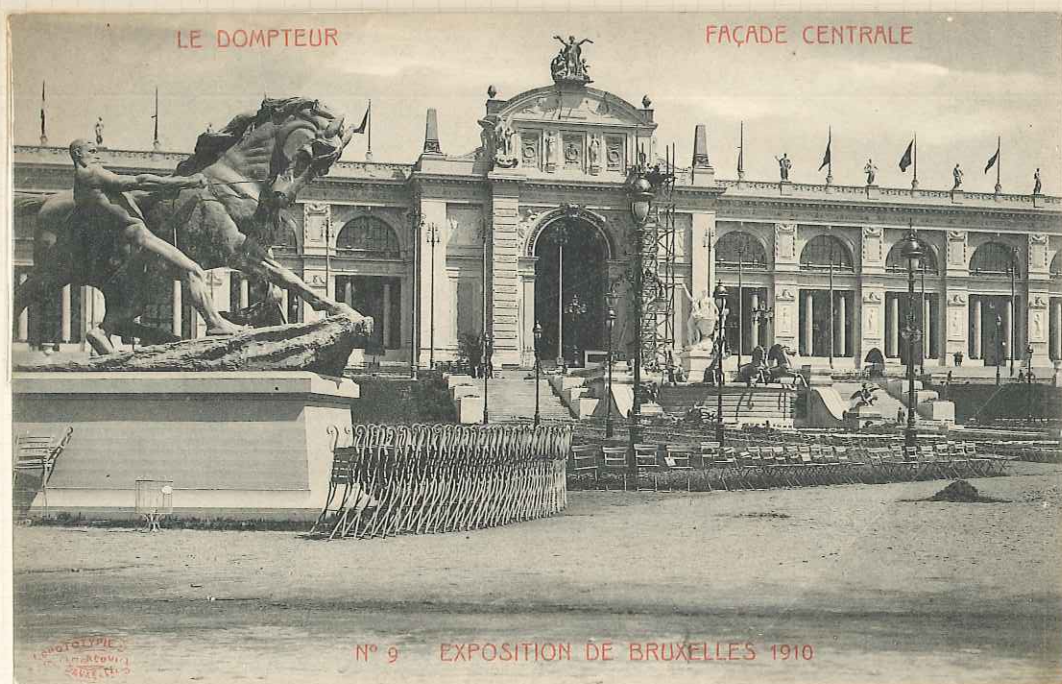

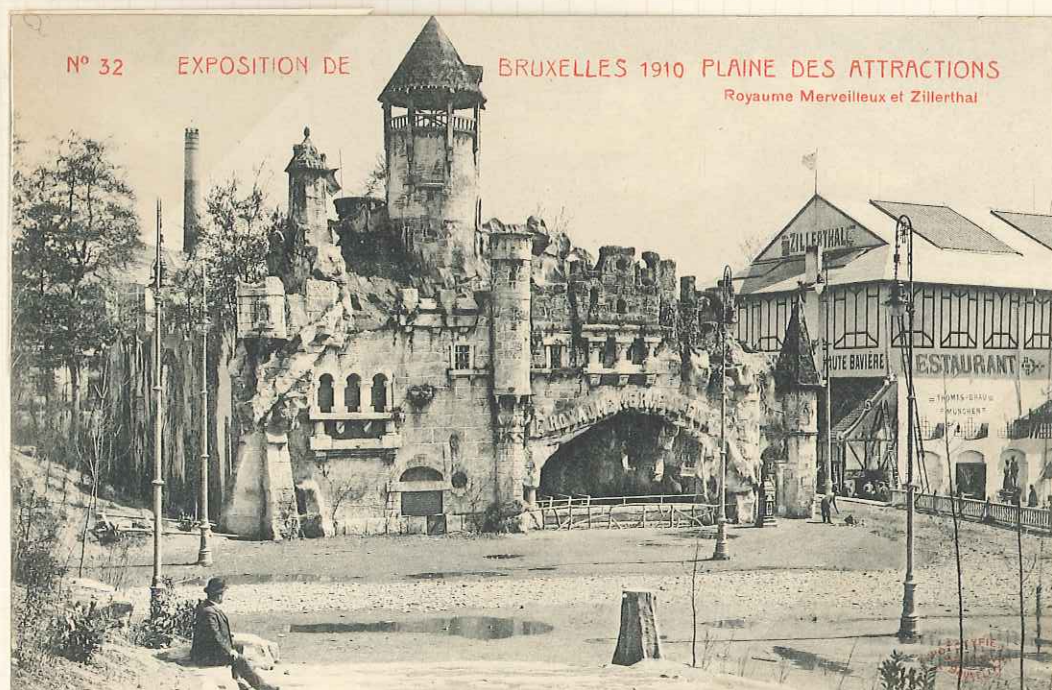

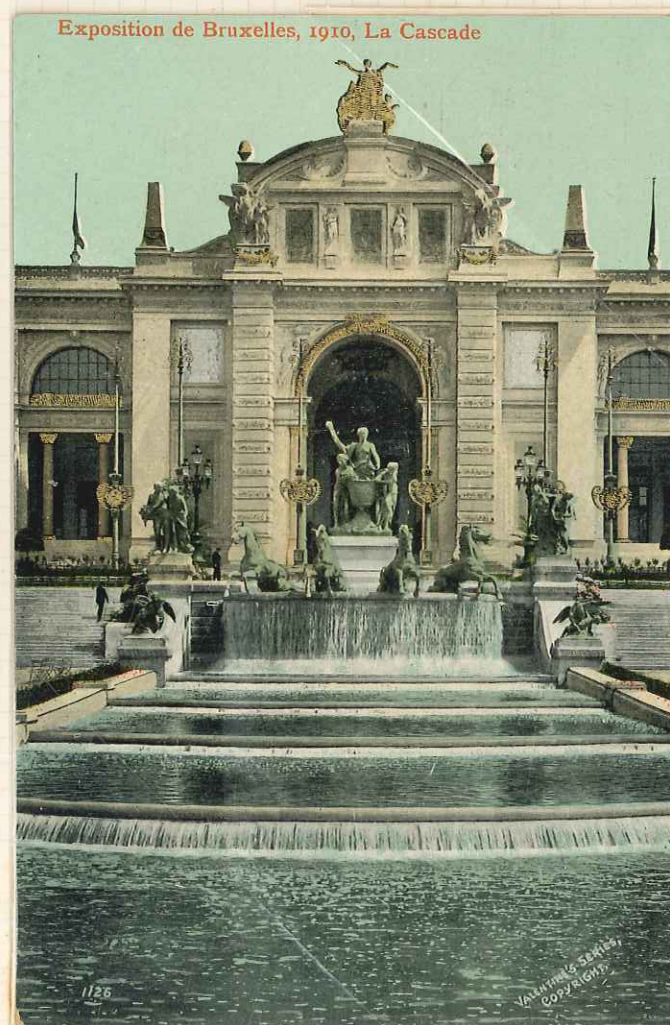

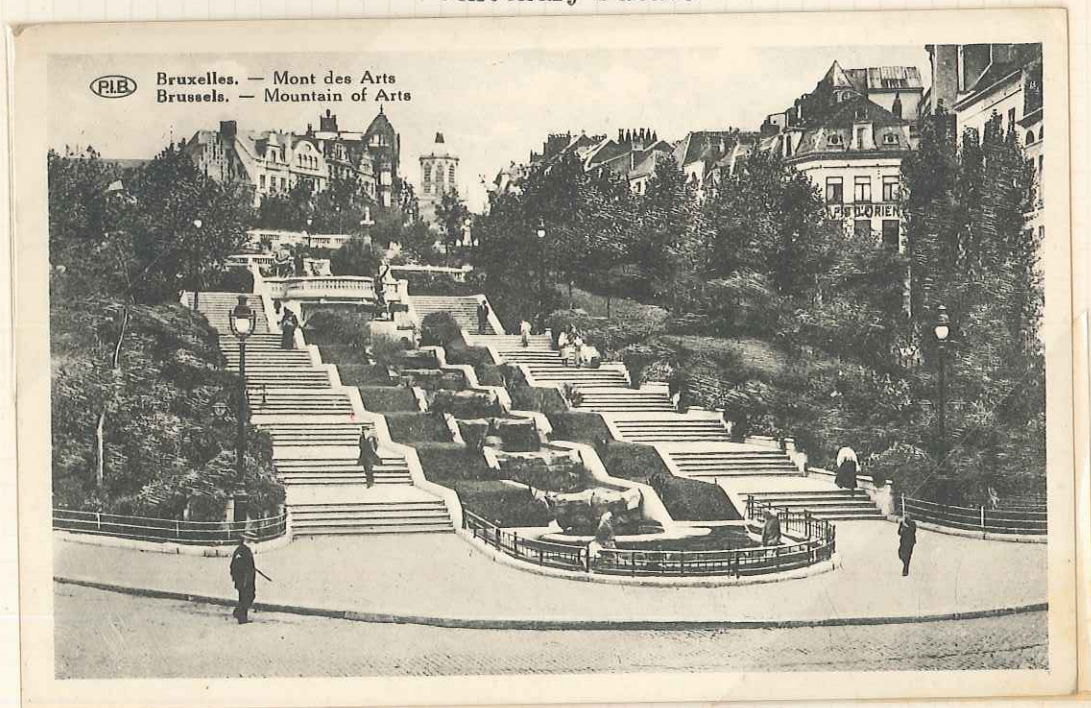

A cover mailed from the Exposition on July 4, 1910
Postage included the first two semi postal issues of Belgium
and the 5 and 20 Centime of the 1905-1907 issue.



The Fair was tremendous and well attended but
on the night of August 14-15 disaster struck. The buildings and
attractions were swept by fire. In a few hours all that remained
was the twisted steelwork and parts or ruins of the buildings and
the animals which lost their lives in the fire.

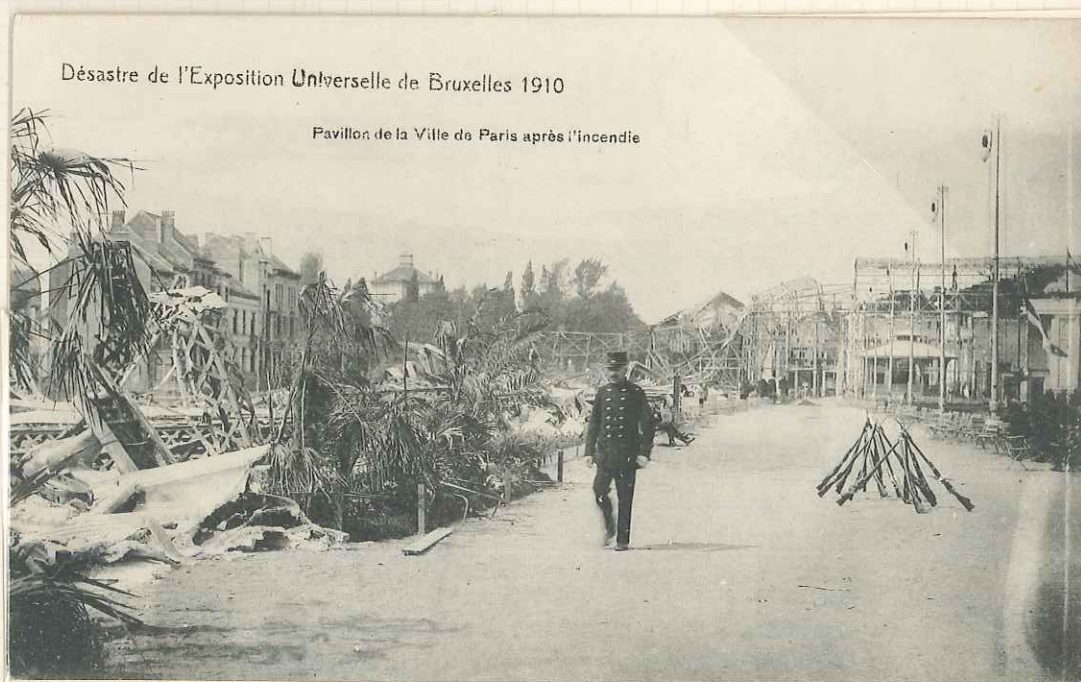

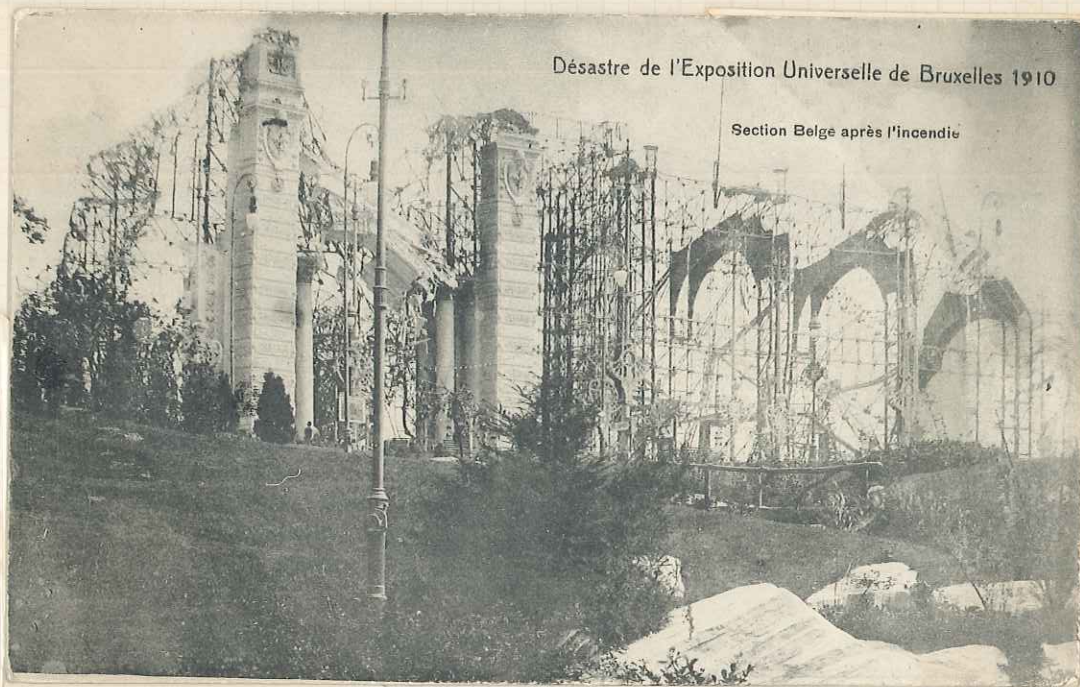

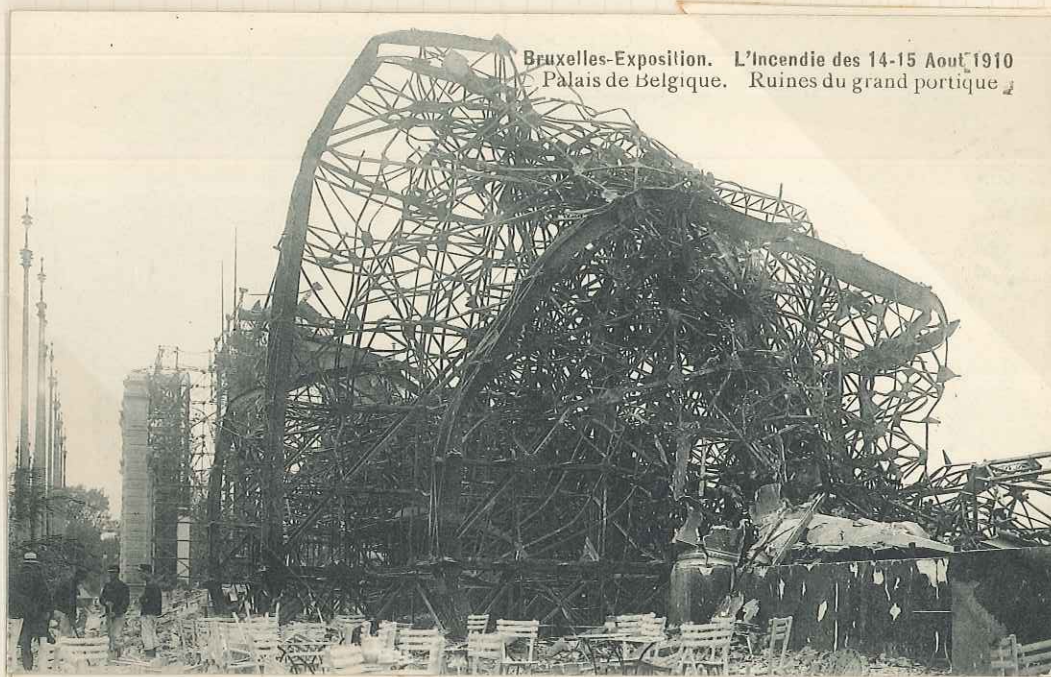

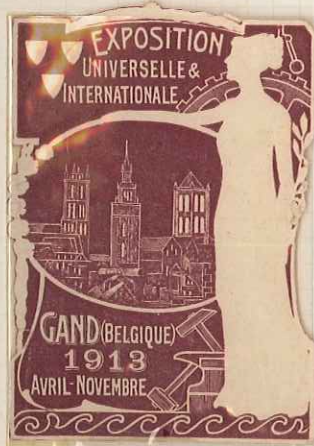
