Charged with maintaining 'Peace and Order' within Mesopotamia the RAF carried out the duties by air and on a number of occasions official mail was also carried to military depots, installations and forces in the field. In some instances this official mail was stamped with official circular handstamps, with many being not handstamped at all. The letters had to be signed for on receipt by the Officer receiving these letters on arrival at the aircraft landing ground.

Official cover flown on an internal flight between Baghdad and Mosel, no postage payable as the letter is from Headquarters in Baghdad to Headquarters, Iraq Services, Mosul. On arrival at Baghdad's Hinaidi airport in the late afternoon of 1 January 1927 the Royal Air Force concluded a remarkable and memorable episode in its life as a military service, transporting civilian and official correspondence for five years and three months on 137 east bound air mail flights between Cairo and Baghdad and 136 west bound flights between Baghdad and Cairo.

Henceforth all air mail between Iraq and Egypt and return would carried by Imperial Airways aircraft departing Basra on Friday 7 January 1927 to Baghdad (overnight stop), Rutbah and Gaza (overnight stop) arriving at Cairo on Sunday morning. The return flight over the same route in reverse commenced on Wednesday 12 January 1927, arriving back in Basra on Friday.

IMPERIAL AIRWAYS TAKES OVER THE AIR MAIL SERVICE FROM THE RAF, JANUARY 1927

After flying the "furrow" since October 1921 the RAF handed over its duties to Imperial Airways on 1 January 1927, with the airline flying their De Havilland DH 66 "Hercules" aircraft and adding Basra to the route from Cairo on a fortnightly service.




