Sent from Francistown 12 April 1915 bearing KG V 6d (SG 81), 1/- SG 82 (* 8) and 1/- Unappropriated Die (SG 15).

Mining activities commenced in 1868 and terminated in the first quarter of the 1900's. Sporadic mining and exploration continued to the end of the 1900's with increasing interest from 2008 with the increase in gold price.


