

PRINTED BY THE LOCAL POSTMASTERS WITH THE WORDS
TIBERIAS EMERGENCY POST - 17⁷ 727
THESE WERE OVERPRINTED IN BLACK AND VIOLET INK ONLY.

INTERIM PERIOD STAMPS.

THE BLOCK OF FOUR IS OF THE 10 MILS BLUE STAMP DEPICTING DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, FIRST PRESIDENT OF ISRAEL. THESE HAVE BEEN CANCELLED BY HAND WITH A RED RUBBER STAMP AT TEL-AVIV, THE SMALL STAMP IN THE LEFT CORNER HAS A TEL-AVIV VIOLET CANCELLATION, WHICH IS MORE COMMON. THIS STAMP DEPICTS ELIEZER BEN-YEHUDA, THE CREATOR OF MODERN HEBREW. THESE STAMPS WERE IN ISSUE FROM THE 13TH APRIL 1948 TO THE 15TH MAY 1948.

INTERIM PERIOD STAMPS.

THE 5 MILS AND 10 MILS, BROWN AND BLUE IN THE BOTTEM RIGHT CORNER DEPICT THE NECEV - WATER PIPE LINE DEVELOPMENT SCHEME. THE 2 MILS GREEN AND 10 MILS VIOLET DEPICT THEODOR HERZL, WHO FOUNDED THE WORLD ZIONIST MOVEMENT. ALL THESE FOUR STAMPS ALL HAVE THE TEL-AVIV VIOLET RUBBER HAND STAMP. THE 5 MILS BLUE JERUSALEM STAMP IS IN THE LEFT HAND CORNER AND THIS HAS BEEN CANCELLED BY THE TEL-AVIV RED HAND STAMP. THE SMALL 10 MILS GREEN SHOWS THE HEBREW TECHNIUM AT HAIFA. THE LARGER STAMP ADJOINING, 10 MILS GREEN SHOWS A SCENE FROM RAMAT GAN WHICH IS COMMEMORATING ITS 25TH ANNIVERSARY.

RISHON LE ZION

RISHON LE ZION WAS ISOLATED DURING THE WAR OF INDEPENDENCE, BEING SURROUNDED BY ARAB SETTLEMENTS, BUT A PASSENGER AND GOODS TRAFFIC WAS MAINTAINED BY TRANSPORTATION IN ARMOURD CARS. USE OF THESE ARMOURD CARS WAS MADE TO RUN AN EXPRESS DAILY POSTAL SERVICE. SPECIAL STAMPS WERE PRINTED, THE CHARGE BEING 40 MILS. PER LETTER. A SPECIAL POSTMARK WAS ALSO INTRODUCED. OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE OF THE LOCAL COUNCIL WAS CARRIED FREE. THE STAMPS WERE SOLD AT THE WORKERS RESTAURANT IN RISHON LE ZION ONLY.

THE 5 MILS BROWN BLOCK OF FOUR IN THE RIGHT CORNER SHOWS A PORTRAIT OF ELIEZER BEN-YEHUDA, CREATOR OF MODERN HEBREW, THE 3 MILS GREEN IN THE CENTRE DEPICTS THE TIRAT-TZVI SETTLEMENT, AND THE 5 MILS BROWN IN THE LEFT CORNER SHOWS A PLOUGHING TRACTOR. THE LATTER TWO BLOCKS ARE FROM A SET DEPICTING DEVELOPMENT AND DEFENCE. ALL ARE CANCELED WITH TEL-AVIV VIOLET.

SHAMIR, TEL AVIV, EACH SHEET CONSISTING OF 4 PAGES BY 15 STAMPS. TWO PAGES WITH VALUE AND 2 PAGES WITH THE VALUE OMITTED. THE STAMPS WERE ISSUED, PERFORATE AND IMPERFORATE.


