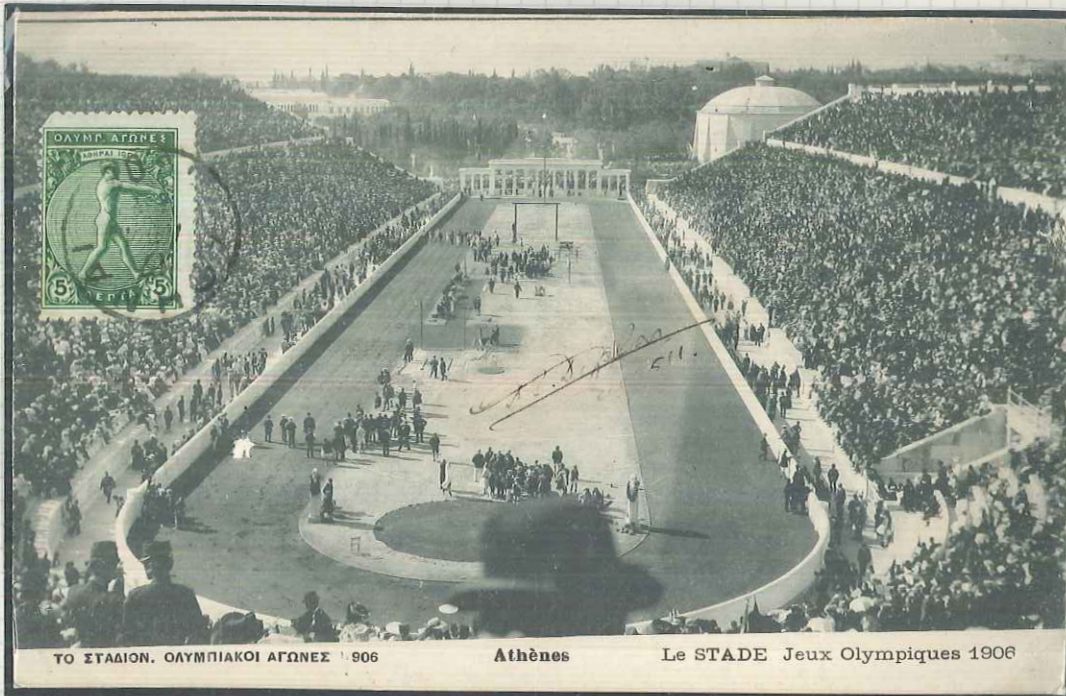

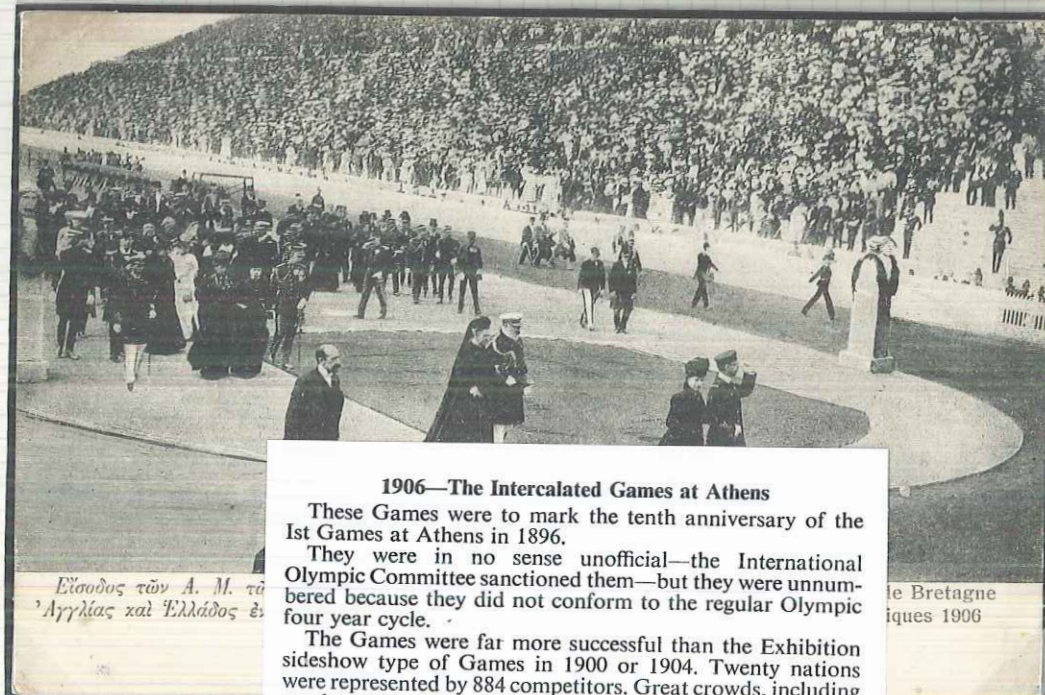

1906—The Intercalated Games at Athens

These Games were to mark the tenth anniversary of the 1st Games at Athens in 1896.

They were in no sense unofficial—the International Olympic Committee sanctioned them—but they were unnumbered because they did not conform to the regular Olympic four year cycle.

The Games were far more successful than the Exhibition sideshow type of Games in 1900 or 1904. Twenty nations were represented by 884 competitors. Great crowds, including a galaxy of royalty, thronged to the marble stadium.

There were 11 sports including 22 track and field, 16 shooting and 8 fencing events.

The individual hero was Paul H. Pilgrim (U.S.A.) who financed his own journey to Athens and won the 400 and 800 metres double.

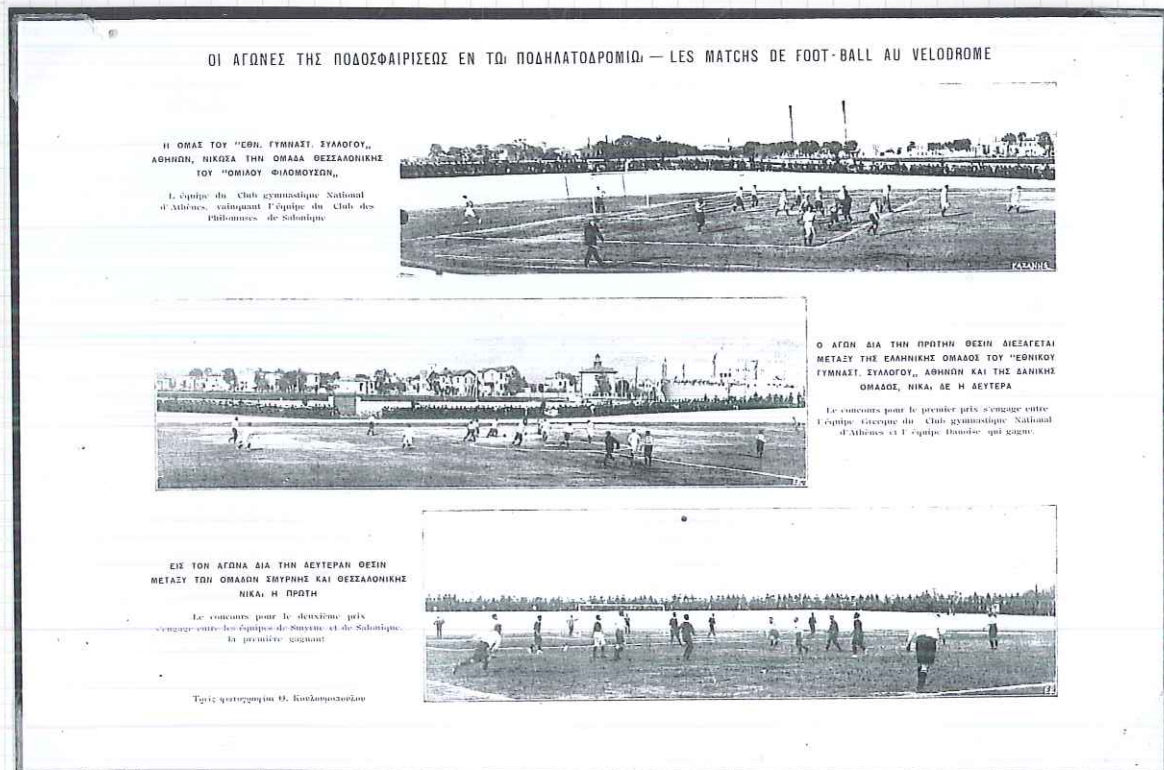
