
1928, "PAQUEBOT"


1926, 1/8 Pia. and 1/4 Pia. in blocks of four on cover from Jeddah (19.3.27)) via Aleppo (29.3) to Beirut. A scarce franking and destination.



1926, ½ Pia. on wrapper from Mecca to London. A rarely seen rate.



½ Pia. with 1929, 1 ¾ G. pair on reverse of cover from Jeddah (31.12.29) via Port Taufiq (4.1.30) and Cairo (5.1) to Karachi (13.1). A very early advertising cover.



1926, 1 Pia. violet on official registered cover from Taif (20.8.32) via Jeddah (21.8) and Alexandria (30.8) to Brussels, only paying the registration fee. A rare rate.

1926, ¼ Pia (3) as ¾ Pia. printed matter rate from Mecca to Germany (1934) with the ½ Pia. War victims tax stamp. A very scarce rate.
