2 October 1933: First flight, Rangoon to Calcutta, franked 8As.

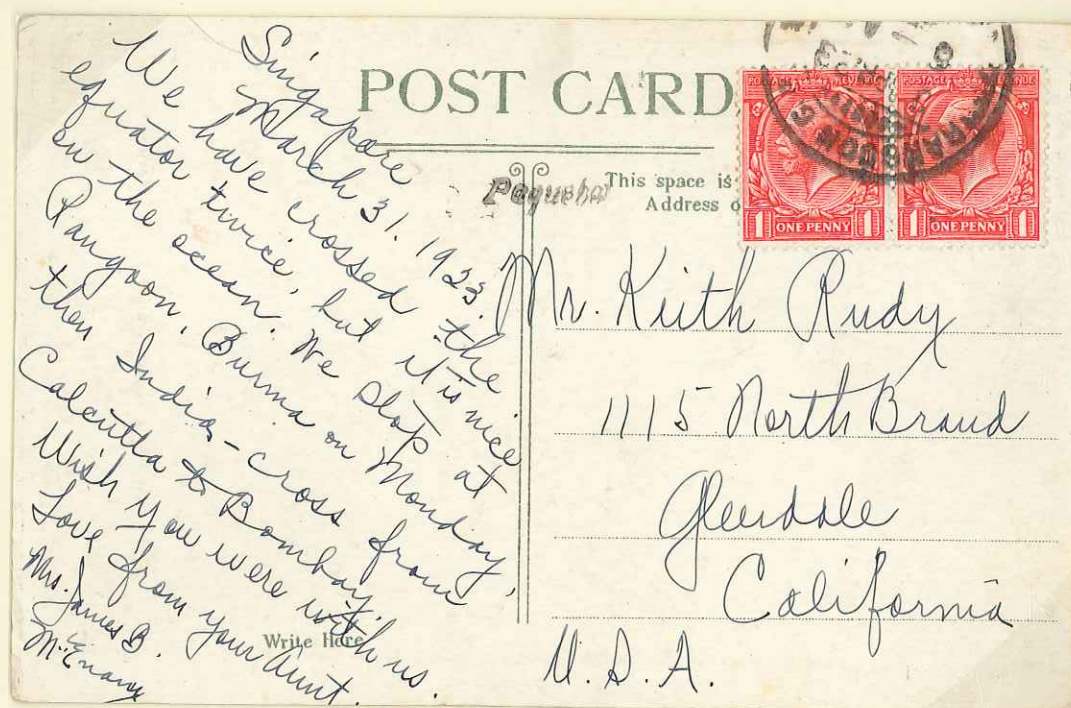


6 December 1936: Airmail to Bombay, arrived 10 December.



5 August 1940: Airmail front to India, franked 3As.

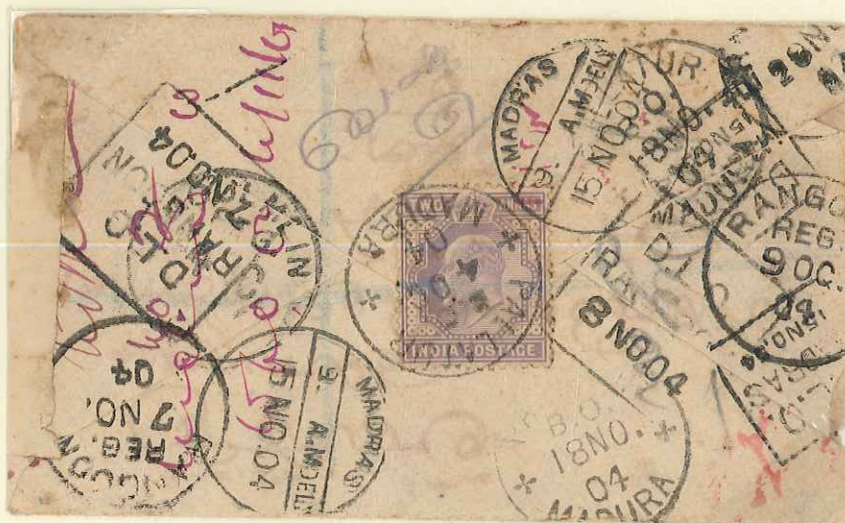




31 March 1923: Postcards written in Singapore to the U.S.A. posted in Rangoon 3 April (E.R.D.).



1 August 1897: ½A P.S. envelope missent to D.L.O. 9 August, redirected to Shwedaung, arrived 10 August.



4 October 1904: Registered letter to Rangoon, arrived 9 October, readdressed to Moulmein, arrived 11 October, endorsed not known to D.L.O. 7 – 8 November and returned to India, arriving 8 November.





11 December 1913: ½A P.S. envelope to India, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 12 December, also struck with D6, arrived 21 December.



24 June 1914: Letter posted in Rangoon, badly addressed to D.L.O. 24 June, endorsed Konapet, India arrived July.

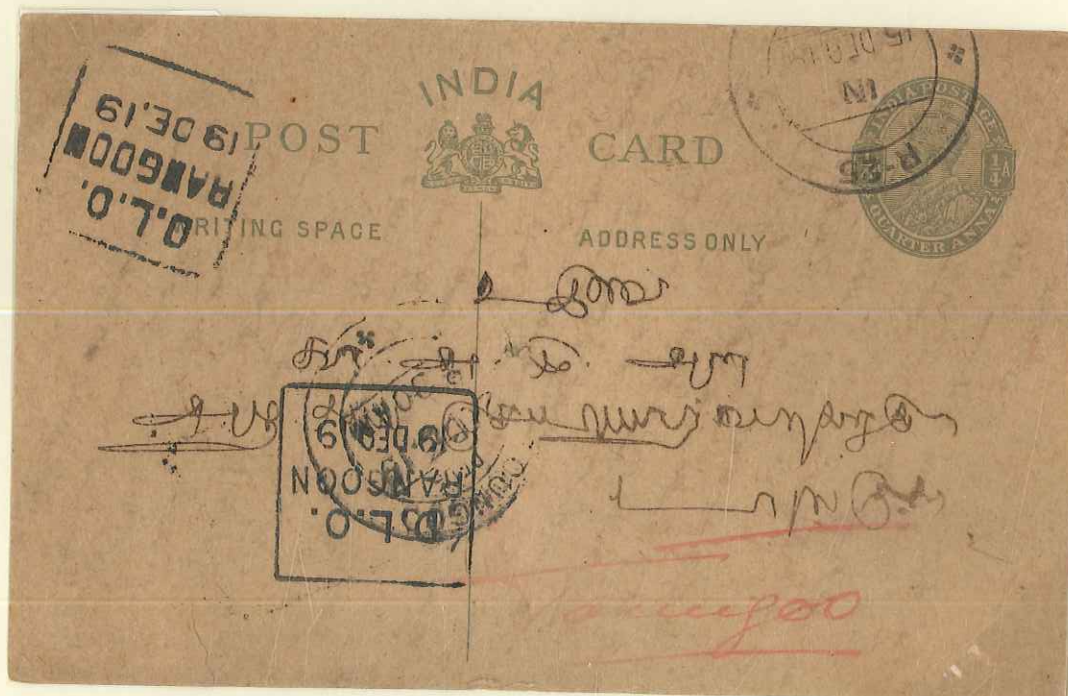


27 June 1907: Letter, Zigon to India, undelivered and returned to D.L.O. 16 July 1907.

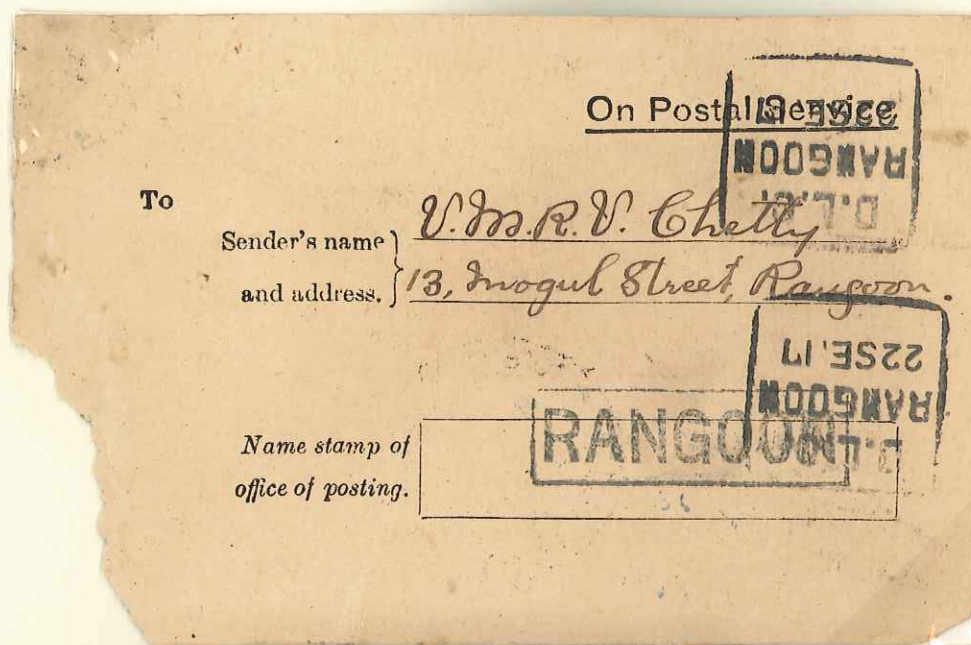




16 August 1913: Letter to Saigon, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 16 August, endorsed Saigon and forwarded, arrived 2 September as it was under franked (1A instead of 2½As) 40cts charged on arrival.



16 December 1919: ¼A postcard posted on T.P.O. R25 but badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 19 December, where it was endorsed "Toungoo", arriving 20 December.

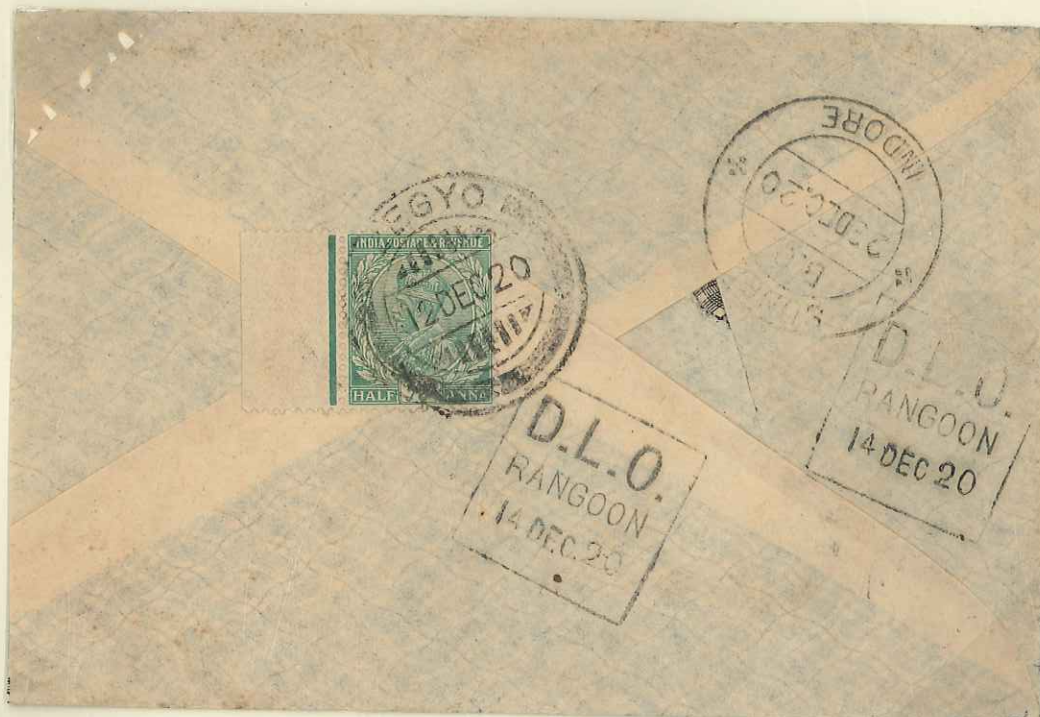


19 September 1917: Registered AR letter to Bassein arrived 20 September, endorsed "address not known" and returned 21 September to Rangoon, arrived 22 September, to D.L.O. to return to sender.





19 June 1920: Pyinmana to Hmawbi, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 21 – 23 June (L.R.D.) arrived 24 June.

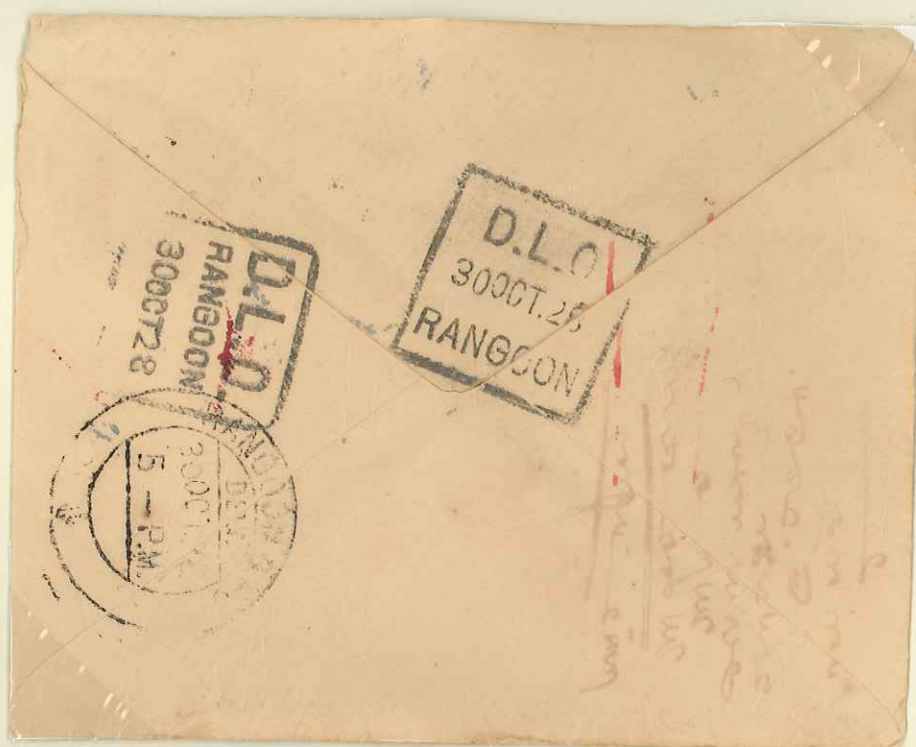


12 December 1920: Zegyo to India, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 14 December (E.R.D.) where it was endorsed with the post town, arrived 23 December.



14 July 1924: Letter, Guernsey to Mandalay, arrived 7 August endorsed "Left 7.8." returned 14 August to D.L.O. Rangoon 15 August, returned 22 September via Bombay 27 September - 3 October.





Two letters, India 25 October and 8 November 1928 sent to D.L.O. 30 October and 13 November (L.R.D.) for better addressing, also struck with D8.



28 November 1927: Registered letter, Germany to Playfair to N.S.S. arrived Lashio 23 December endorsed "Not Known" returned 4 January, Mandalay 7 January, D.L. 9 January 1928, Bombay 16 February, Germany 4 March.





19 August 1929: Letter to Burma, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 27 August (L.R.D.) endorsed Ngathoungyau, arrived 28 August.



26 September 1927: Badly addressed letter, sent to the D.L.O. 28 September (E.R.D) and forwarded to Kyauktaw, arrived 7 October.





6 December 1928: Letter, India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to the D.L.O., 12 December, delivered in Rangoon the same day.



25 July 1929: India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to the D.L.O., 30 July, delivered in Rangoon 31 July.



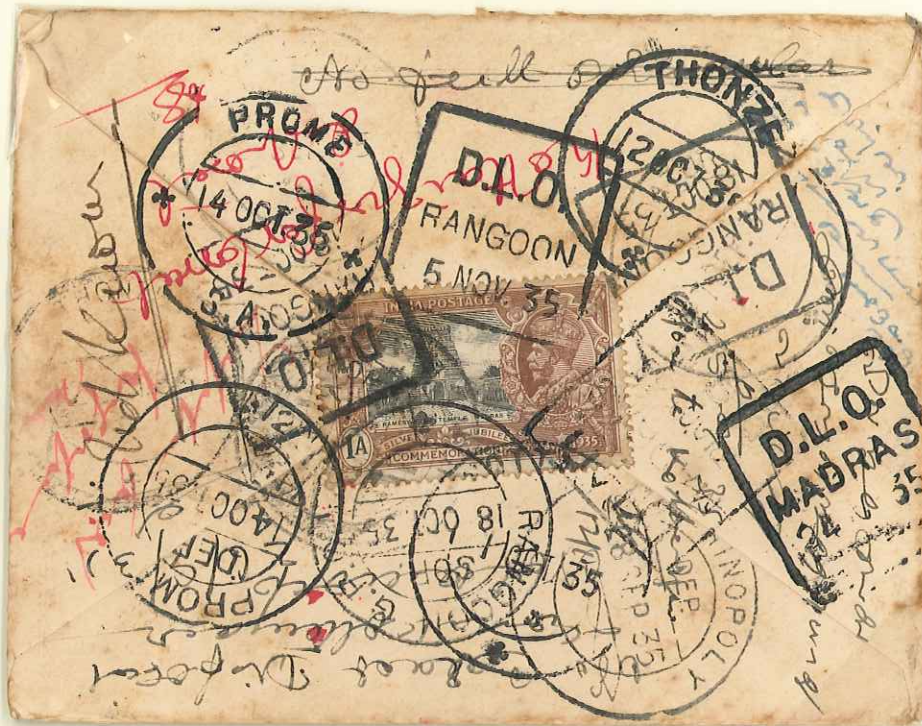
22 October 1931: India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 28 October, endorsed Sagaing, arrived 30 October.

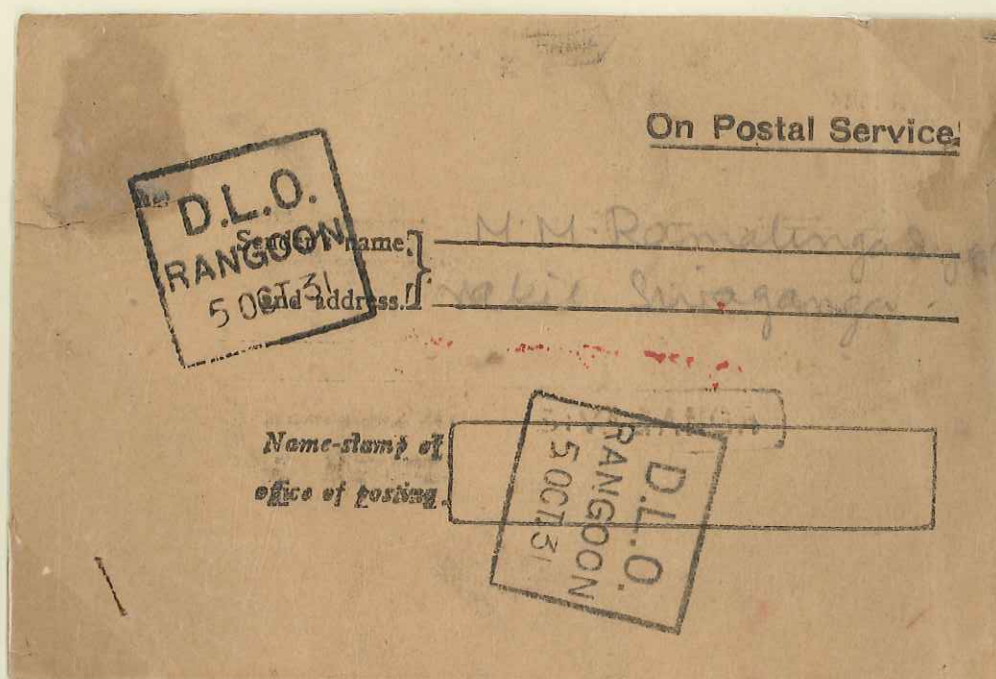


18 September 1935: Under franked letter, Thonze to India, arrived 28 September "not known" and returned via Thonze 12 October, Prome 14 October, but unable to find sender. D.L.O. 18 October – 5 November.



30 April 1936: Letter, India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to the D.L.O. 5 May, endorsed "Padigon", arrived 6 May. Also struck with D12.





5 October 1931 (E.R.D.): Postal Service Card.



13 April 1932: Letter India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to D.L.O. 20 April, endorsed Dabein, arrived 21 April.



20 May 1937: Letter, India to Burma, badly addressed to D.L.O. 26 May, endorsed Hmawbi, arrived 27 May. Also struck with D13.





24 May 1934: Letter, India to Burma, badly addressed so sent to the D.L.O. 29 May, endorsed Kyaikpi, arrived 31 May.



7 February 1938: Letter, India to Burma, badly addressed, so sent to the D.L.O. 16 February, endorsed Kyaiklat, arrived 18 February.

RANGOON D.L.O.



From London, 6 February 1931, by air to Karachi, thence by surface to Bombay, train to Calcutta and British India Steam Navigation Co. by sea to Rangoon, with delivery stamp of 23 February, by machine.

Handstamped RANGOON 24 FEB: it passed through Rangoon / Departmental branch office 3 MAR: As addressee was unknown it arrived at D.L.O. RANGOON 4 MAR 31.

After the statutory one month, on 6 April it left D.L.O. Rangoon and reached, on 11 April D.L.O. Bombay, which it vacated on 17 April 31.

In blue manuscript is "R.L.S. 6/5/31" marked in the U.K.
