When Forgeries of the four annas black appeared and difficulty was experienced in detecting if lightly used stamps with black postmarks were being re-used, the authorities changed the colour to green.



This double letter sheet was written 9 August. Postmarked Moulmein in red on 10 August. Handstamped Bremen in black 2 October. Also a London Paid mark, apparently 30 September. Double the 6anna rate introduced on 3 July 1861. c.d.s. with sans script, rare.
