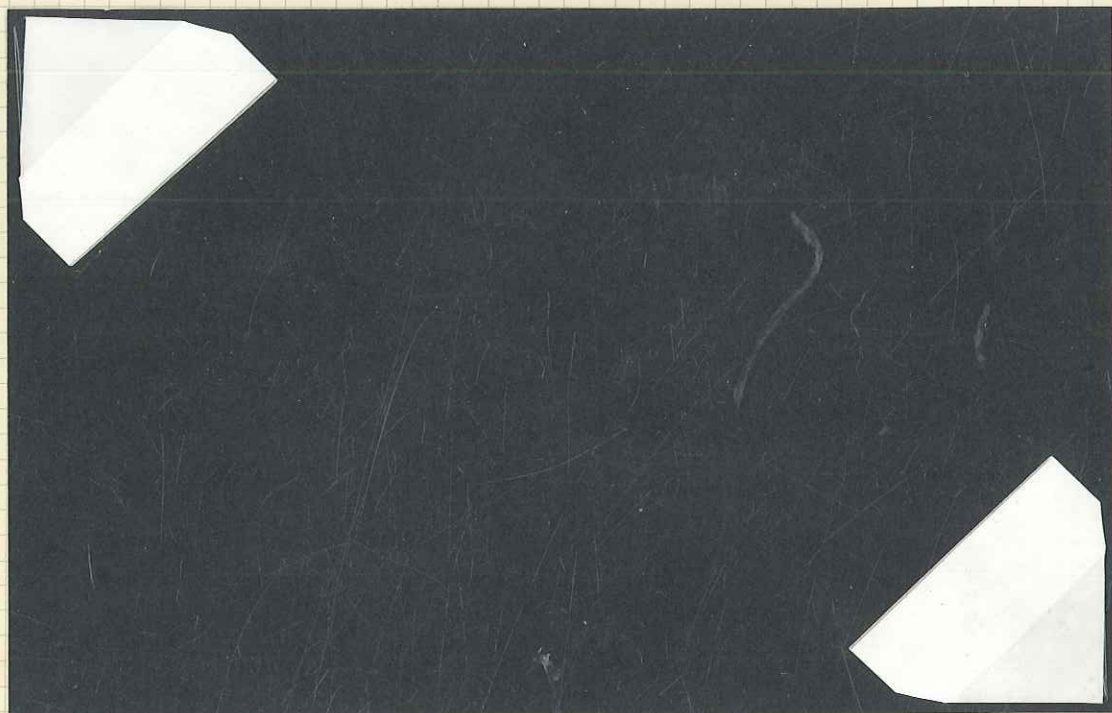



1883 SHIP MAIL ON RIVERS VOLGA AND KAMA

7k stationery envelope to STUTTGART, Germany, picked up by River Kama postal steamer and cancelled

PERM-KAZAN 21 Sep 1883

Backstamps indicate transfer to River Volga postal steamer on 23 Sep and arrival at NIZHNII-NOVGOROD RAILWAY STATION 25 Sep and MOSCOW 26 Sep 1883.

An item posted on the Perm-Kazan route two months earlier has a similar cancellation to the above example though the basal fleuron is not the same, suggesting replacement of the canceller or that variants of the canceller were carried on different ships.
