#### 4. Maritime postmarks.

#### 4.1. Ports postmarks.

The first Russian postmark, which indicated that mail had been carried by ship, was the postmark used at the Kronstadt Port, from where it was taken by British steamers.

Folded letter sent from St.-Petersburg via Kronstadt, from where it was delivered to London by the British steamer "Sirius", which was the first steamer to carry mail across the Atlantic Ocean. Double straight-line postmark, applied at the Kronstadt Port (9.05.1839), used in 1835-1844, and arrival circular postmark of London (30.05.1839 – Gregorian calendar).






