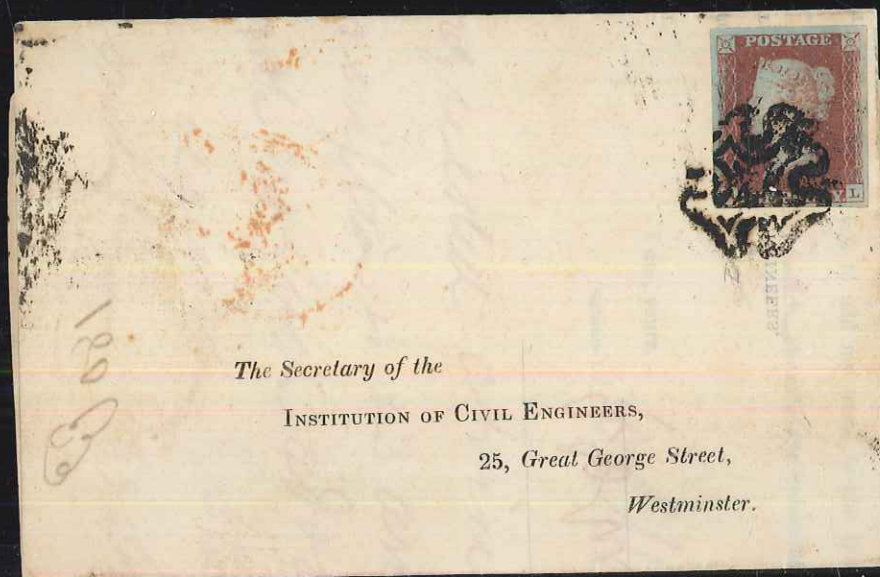
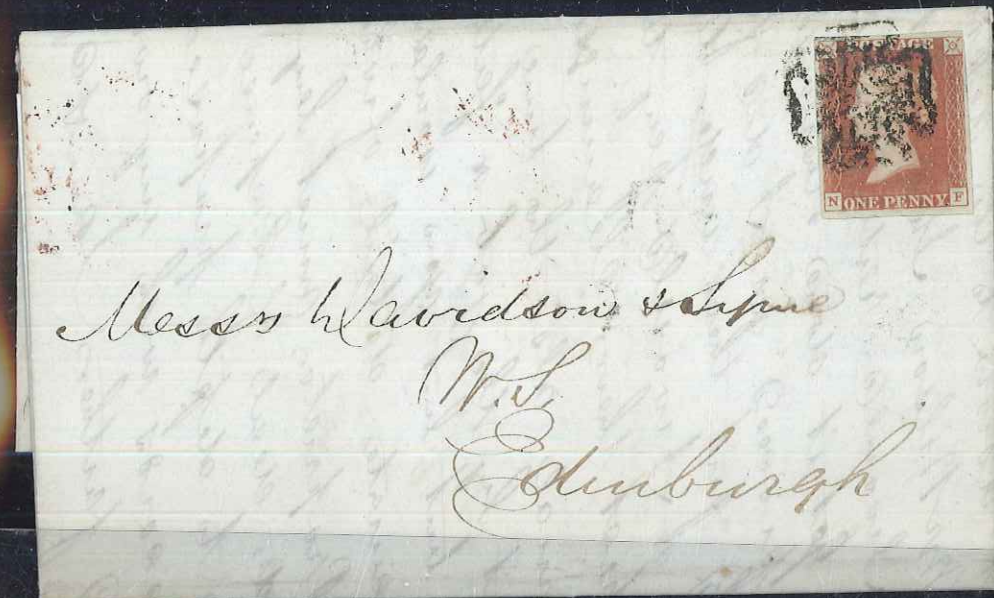

RC fine (Box)

Plate 1b: Basic cat on cover: £ 650

RC1(b)ag

Plate 1b [AG] Fine to very fine stamp with 4 large margins tied to a local London entire (slightly reduced) by a fine black MX and good strike of TP Hope Town. 29 May 1841.

RC1(b)ek

Plate 1b [EK] with 4 good to large margins tied to an unfolded cover from Dumfries to Kendal. Cat 500.00

RC1(b)hc

Plate 1b [HC](Spec AS6h, recut sidelines) with 4 very large margins, just tied to a 4th April 1841 unfolded local Edinburgh entire.

RC1(b)ka

Plate 1b [KA] . Very fine to superb copy, tied by two strikes of the MX to a small, clean unfolded envelope from Horncastle to Woodmancote, 1st September 1841

RC1(b)jj

Plate 1b [JJ] Very fine 4 margin , tied by MX to 12 May 1841 entire from London to Kidderminster. Fine KIDDERMINSTER udc.

Plate 2: Basic cat on cover: £ 475

RC2cj

Plate 2 [CJ] - 4 margin - London (Vere St) to Edinburgh, 18th February 1842.

RC2lf

Plate 2 [LF] - 4 margin with magnificent MX on very fine 27th August 1841 from Brucefield to Hamilton

RC5re

Plate 5: Basic cat on cover: £ 400

Plate 5 RE very fine 4-margin tied by superb black MX to 17 Nov 1841 large part cover from Downham to London

Plate 8: Basic cat on cover: £ 350

RC8adSt2

Plate 8 State 2 re-entry Spec AS54 very fine 4-margin tied to a 21 Aug 41 part cover from Strabane to Dublin by a very fine MX. 'No 4' receiving house mark.

RC8dg

Plate 8 [DG] 4 margins, attractive cover from St Austell to Wellington, arriving on 3 Dec 1841 (no rear markings) . Clean and attractive with front St Austell cds.

RC8oeSt2

Plate 8 OE State 2 - 4-margined copy, affixed inverted (the Irish lèse-majesté?), tied by a type 1 Common MX of Dublin (see Rockoff and Jackson p92) to 25th Aug 1841 entire from Dublin to London ( a page missing, but talking about crossing the Irish Sea!)

RC8olSt2

Plate 8 OL State 2- clear to huge margins, affixed to a 27th April 1841 entire from Linlithgow to Hamilton

RC8sk

Plate 8 [SK]- 4 margin, Wick local, 12th July 1841 . James Loch, one of the supervisors of the Highland Clearances, was later MP for St Germain in Cornwall.

RC9bi

Plate 9: Basic cat on cover: £ 325

Pl 9 [BI]- 4 even margins, Edinburgh local 13th July 1841

RC9eg

Plate 9 [EG] - Four good margins tied by an upright 'thick-margined' Dumfries Cross to a 30 Sept 1841 cover to Edinburgh

RC9fa

Plate 9 [FA] state 2 (Spec AS65) - 4 margin Exeter to Newton Abbott 30th September 1841

| RC9nl   | <p>Plate 9 NL - 4 margin, tied to London local printed entire, 27th May 1841</p> <p><i>Plate 10: Basic cat on cover: £ 325</i></p>   |
| RC10be  | <p>Plate 10 BE (Spec 69a no 'O' flaw in original state) . 4 good to large margins tied by MX to 26th Nov 1841 cover from Warrington to Bradford. Warrington receiver cds (which was on the front, but the cover is now folded with it at the back - easily reversible if you wish!) Bradford arrival cds on front, also tying the stamp.</p> |
| RC10nf  | <p>Plate 10 [NF] - 4 good to very large margins, tied to an excellent unfolded entire from Glasgow to Edinburgh - 3rd May 1841.</p>  |
| RC10oj  | <p>Plate 10 [OJ] Fine 4-margined copy, tied by Edinburgh MX to local Edinburgh entire of 13 Aug 1841</p>   |
