Montserrat Markings Not Applied
(1810-1836)

Packet Boat Mail to England
Receiving Marks
12 September 1833 (reverse)
& 11 May 1835



Much Montserrat mail in this period was carried by mail-boat schooners connecting with Packet Ships. Normally Packet letters went to Falmouth and were then transported to London. Rates, however, were directly calculated as either to Falmouth or London.
