

1900—The IIInd Games at Paris

It was feared that the Second Games would rival the World Exhibition in Paris in the same year, so de Coubertin was subdued and the Games were allowed to be nothing more than a sideshow. Another factor that reduced interest was that the Games in the Bois de Boulogne, Paris, were spread over more than five months. Despite these drawbacks, the standards shot up and quite a few world best performances were set. The hero of the Games was Alvin Kraenzlein (U.S.A.) who won the 60 metres, 110 metres hurdles, 200 metres hurdles, and long jump.
