






The Original 1908 Olympic Poster

The winning design in a competition organised by the British Olympic Council, the poster bears no signature, and no record has been found of the artist's name.

The Franco-British Exhibition organisers were responsible for publicity for the Olympic Games, & bore \$\frac{1}{4}\$, of the cost of the poster, the British Olympic Association, \$\frac{1}{6}\$, up to a maximum of \$\frac{1}{6}\$100

Exhibition layout showing the 1908 Olympic Stadium





1908 Franco-British Exhibition

Airship Disaster

A Captain Lovelace planned to fly over the exhibition site in his hydrogen filled airship. The airship was 70ft long and 16ft in circumference and looked like a sausage. From it hung a 40ft spruce frame housing a 20hp petrol engine.



While carrying out a Captain final inspection Lovelace noticed a vent in the webbing which covered the hydrogen filled silk envelope. He asked his private secretary, Miss Blanch Hill, aged 21, to sew it up. He had hardly left the tent when there was a terrific explosion and the tent and airship went up in flames. Miss Hill died instantly and two other people died later from burns


