Herewith the mock-up cover that Mr Harman sent to STAMP COLLECTING for his advertisement (which is also enclosed). I hope you received the summons I got at the time of the case which I sent to you on 14th April. I still can't find the cover I bought and the cheque which was used to pay for it and which was produced in court. I found an enormous collection of material in connection with the World Cup in 1966 and many copies of the 'English Winners' stamps on piece commercially used at the time. By the way the Jules Rimet (?) cup for the world cup winner was stolen on the place next to us at STAMPEX in 1966 in the Central Hall Westminster and I remember caused alot of red faces! The display cabinet was just next to the STAMP COLLECTING stand.
