June 1, 1923





Posted MARYBOROUGH on June 1, 1923, and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service"

London - Cairo - Baghdad.

Mails left London on June 14 and Cairo on June 22, and Baghdad was reached on June 23.

BAGHDAD and BAGHDAD CANTONMENT arrival postmarks of June 24.

### IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR EARLY AIRMAIL SERVICES LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD

July 27, 1923 / August 25, 1923



Posted Stradbally, Queens County, on July 27, 1923, and carried by <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u> "desert airmail service".


BAGHDAD transit postmark of August 19, 10.30 a.m., and BAGHDAD CANTONMENT arrival postmark of August 19, 3.00 p.m.



Posted Maryborough on August 25, 1923, and carried by <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u> "desert airmail service". BAGHDAD arrival postmark of September 16, 10.30 a.m.

January 1, 1924






Posted Dublin on January 1, 1924,
and carried on January 10 with <u>London - Paris - Zurich</u>
and on January 18 with <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u> "desert" airmail service by R.A.F.
Baghdad was reached after many mishaps on January 22 (Proud, Vol. 1, p. 29).

BAGHDAD H.O. arrival postmarks of January 23, 8.00 a.m., and January 24, 9.00 a.m.
First Irish acceptances at reduced airmail fee of 3d for Cairo - Baghdad service?

# IRISH ACCEPTANCE FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE": LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD

January 29, 1924





Posted **BAILE ÁTHA CLIATH** on January 29, 1924, with Harrison coils (strip of 4 of T63 and single T62), and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service"

<u>London - Cairo - Baghdad</u>.

Mails left London on February 7 and Cairo on February 15, and Baghdad was reached on February 16. **BAGHDAD** arrival postmarks of February 16, 3.00 p.m.

## IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE" LONDON - PARIS - (CAIRO) (BAGHDAD3 AU)

October 21, 1924

Three covers, all posted Maryborough on October 21, 1924, carried by <u>London – Paris</u> airmail service and forwarded to Alexandria. **ALEXANDRIA** arrival postmarks of October 29, 8.30 a.m.

"London – Cairo airmail" at that time meant airmail transport London – Paris only.



February 10, 1925






Posted registered **DUBLIN / DUKE ST.** on February 10, 1925, with pair of 2d stamps including "<u>long 1</u>" variety (T65a), and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" <u>London - Cairo - Baghdad</u>. Forwarded to <u>Khartoum</u>, Sudan.

indistinct LONDON / REGISTERED transit postmark,
WADI HALFA / REGISTERED transit postmark of February 26
and KHARTOUM / REGISTERED arrival postmark of February 28.

# IRISH ACCEPTANCE FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE": LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD FORWARDED TO KHARTOUM

February 12, 1925





Posted registered **DUBLIN / COLLEGE GREEN** (rubber cds) on February 12, 1925, with three 2d "long 1" variety (T65a), a pair of ½d (T62) and pair of 1d (T21) overprints, and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" London - Cairo - Baghdad. Forwarded to Khartoum, Sudan.

LONDON / REGISTERED transit postmark of February 13, indistinct WADI HALFA / REGISTERED transit postmark and KHARTOUM / REGISTERED arrival postmark of February 28.

# IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE" LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD AND FORWARDED TO TEHERAN

March 6, 1925





Two similar covers, both posted Dublin on March 6, 1925, and carried by R.A.F. "Desert Airmail service" <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u>. Forwarded to <u>Teheran</u>, Persia, by surface transportation.

BAGHDAD transit postmarks of March 28 and TEHERAN arrival postmarks of April 12.

## IRISH ACCEPTANCE FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE": LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD

March 25, 1925





Posted BAILE ÁTHA CLIATH on March 25, 1925, carried with airmail service by Imperial Airways London - Zurich and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" Cairo - Mosul.


Amazing MOSUL arrival postmark of April 3.

Re-directed via Baghdad to Telafar, with BAGHDAD transit postmark of April 11 and TELAFAR arrival postmark of April 17.

The regular Cairo - Baghdad airmail service left London on April 2 and Cairo on April 9, reaching Baghdad on April 10,

## IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE": LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD


July 28, 1925 / October 5, 1925



Posted **BAILE ÁTHA CLIATH** on July 28, 1925. Mails left London on August 6, were carried with <u>London - Zurich</u> airmail service by Imperial Airways and were carried on August 13 with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u>.

Baghdad was reached on August 14.

BAGHDAD H.Q. arrival postmark of August 14.



Posted **BAILE ÁTHA CLIATH** on October 5, 1925. Mails left London on October 15, were carried with <u>London - Zurich</u> airmail service by Imperial Airways and were carried on October 22 with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u>.


Baghdad was reached on October 24.

## IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE": LONDON - CAIRO - BAGHDAD

August 18, 1925 / August 19, 1925





Posted **BAILE ÁTHA CLIATH** on August 18 and on August 19, 1925.

Mails left London on August 20,

were carried with <u>London - Zurich</u> airmail service by Imperial Airways and were carried on August 27 with R.A.F. "desert airmail service"

Cairo - Baghdad.

Baghdad was reached on August 28.
Both covers carried with same service
and with **BAGHDAD H.Q.** arrival postmarks of August 28.

### EARLY REGISTERED IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE" CAIRO - BAGHDAD

August 19, 1925 / September 22, 1925



Registered cover, posted Dublin, Dame Street, on August 19, 1925, and carried by R.A.F. Desert Airmail Service Cairo - Baghdad. LONDON REGISTERED transit postmark of August 20 and (unrecorded) BAGHDAD CANTONMENT / REG. arrival postmark of August 29.



Registered cover, posted Dublin, Harcourt Road, on Septen and carried by R.A.F. Desert Airmail Service Cairo - I LONDON REGISTERED transit postmark of September (unrecorded) BAGHDAD CANTONMENT / REG. arrival postmark The overprinted 9d stamp shows the frameline break variety.

June 25, 1924




Posted registered **DUBLIN / COLLEGE GREEN** on June 25, 1924, and carried with R.A.F. "Desert Airmail Service" <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u>. Forwarded to <u>Teheran</u>, Persia, by surface transport. **LONDON REGISTÉRED** transit postmark of June 26, **BAGHDAD IRAQ REG.** transit postmark of July 4,
and (probably) **TEHERAN** arrival postmark of July 16.

4 of the six stamps have been tampered with (inserted accents and missing accents).

### IRISH ACCEPTANCES FOR R.A.F. "DESERT AIRMAIL SERVICE" LONDON - PARIS - (CAIRO)


October 21, 1924



Posted Maryborough on October 21, 1924, carried by <u>London – Paris</u> airmail service and forwarded to Alexandria. **ALEXANDRIA** arrival postmark of October 29, 8.30 a.m.

"London – Cairo airmail" at that time meant airmail transport London – Paris only.


"Long 1 in 1922" variety on the ½d Harrison coil stamp.

January 21, 1925



Registered cover, posted in Dublin on January 21, 1925, and carried by R.A.F. Desert Airmail Service <u>Cairo - Baghdad</u> and forwarded to <u>Khartoum</u>, Sudan.

London transit postmark of January 22 and Khartoum arrival postmarks of January 31 and February 3.
