Great Britain, 6<sup>th</sup> May 1840, Mulready Envelope, Forme A156, Stereo  
A156 sent from Paris 3/1/1858 with France, Empire, 10 C. bistre and  
20 C. bleu, the 10 C. tied by red boxed „PD“ to Chateau Zeil near  
Leutkirch in Württemberg, re-addressed to Kenzingen, Baden and  
finally Munich is genuine in every respect.

SG ME2, Ceres 13l, 14l.

30 C.-Rate to Württemberg (1<sup>st</sup> Rayon) valid from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1857.  
German tax of „12“ Kr. corrected to 9 Kr. for long distance rate in  
Germany.

An exceptional usage of the Mulready. No similar franking recorded  
in the famous collections such as Yates, Alcock, Giamporcaro etc.
