I have examined the above item and, in my opinion, it is genuine in all aspects

Notes: The stamps have been lifted and replaced. Closed tear at the lower left corner of the 30r and horizontal crease affecting the 90r value. The franking pays the basic maritime rate in Brazil. The letter is addressed to Joaquim Pinto Siete In Porto and it seem likely, due to the lack of arrival markings, that it was delivered to him directly by the Captain of the vessel that originally picked up the letter. The 90r is from the Second Composite Plate State C, Pos. 1 and the 30r is from the Second Composite Plate State B, Pos. 8. The only recorded example of this cancel on a Bulls Eye cover. Ex Ferreira
