

**"AIR MAIL / GENERAL HEAD QUARTER / BRITISH FORCES IRAQ":  
BAGHDAD – CAIRO – LONDON – DUBLIN**

**November 5, 1922**



**"GOVERNMENT OF INDIA"** stationary, posted Baghdad on November 5, 1922, and carried by Baghdad – Cairo airmail service operated by the R.A.F. Forwarded via London to Dublin and re-directed on November 15 from **Dublin F.P.O. D.41** to Shorncliffe, Kent. Highly unusual with double ring cachet in violet on the back **"AIR MAIL / GENERAL HEAD QUARTER / BRITISH FORCES IRAQ"**.

April 14, 1922

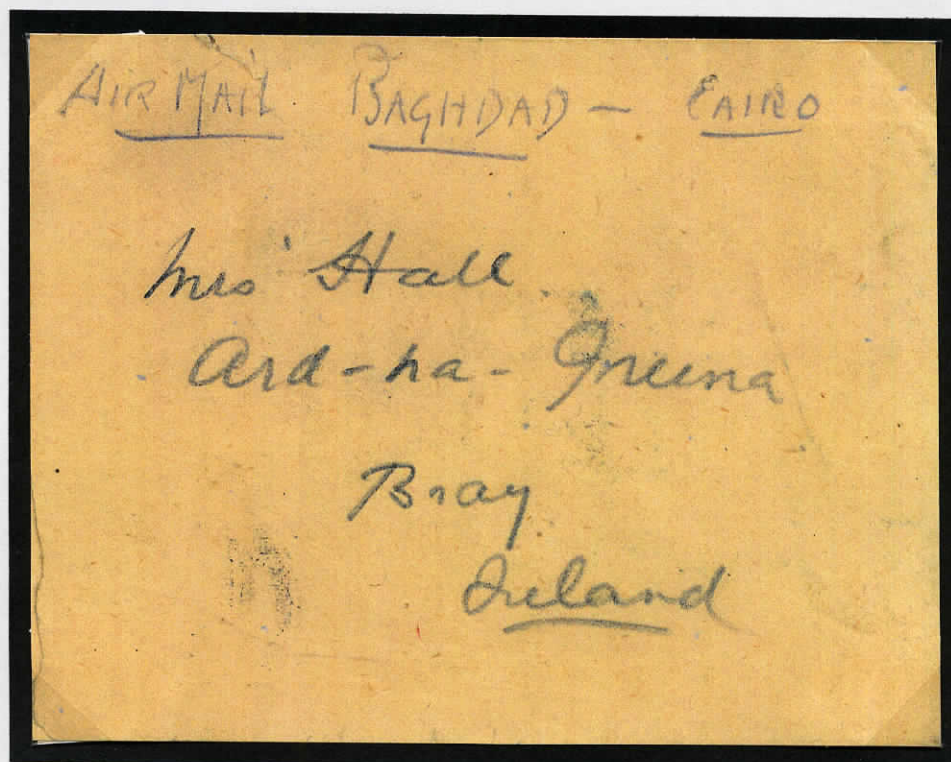


Posted Baghdad on April 14, 1922, and carried

**"R.A.F. AIRMAIL BAGHDAD - CAIRO":  
BAGHDAD - CAIRO - LONDON - BRAY**

**September 14, 1922**



Posted **BAGHDAD** on September 14, 1922,  
and carried with R.A.F. "desert airmail service" Baghdad - Cairo  
and forwarded Cairo - London and London - Bray.  
Mails left Baghdad on September 15 and Cairo on September 17,  
and London was reached on September 26.
