I have examined the sheet of stamped paper of Greece, 1 Dr., bearing the typewritten text of a deed dated 1914, to which is affixed a fiscal stamp of Greece, 1910, 5 Dr., overprint "Themis" (= Justice) on postage stamp of the 1906 Olympic issue (Forbin Catalogue, No.9). The stamp is pen-cancelled by a cypher that ties it to the heading of the stamped paper. A photographic reproduction is attached to this certificate. In my opinion, this item is genuine, i.e. the stamp bears genuine overprint and it was originally used on this document: I initialled it "ED".* * * * *
