This strip present a puzzle. It cannot be plated with any of the characteristics of the A stone easily. No specific cliches appear to be apparent.

The appearance of the first character on the bottom line indicates an A stone printing (the two are joined where they are not joined in the B stone)

It appears to be from the top four rows, but not of right or left margin.

The rouletting "rule" does not reach to the top.

The date is odd.

Bills mentions the use of $\frac{1}{4}$ anna with late cancellations. Also possible use of stamp in 1880's (Medhora). Also possible new A sheet used after B sheet. Does this strip help in any of this???

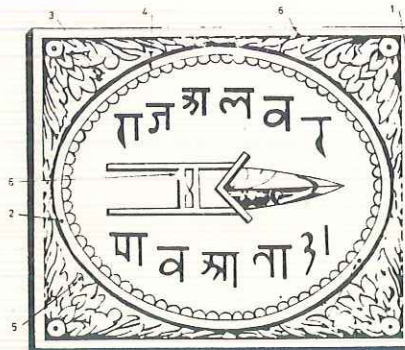

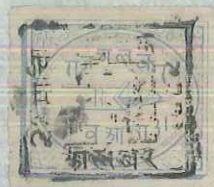

Thank you again for your help and best wishes with your Jhalawar project.

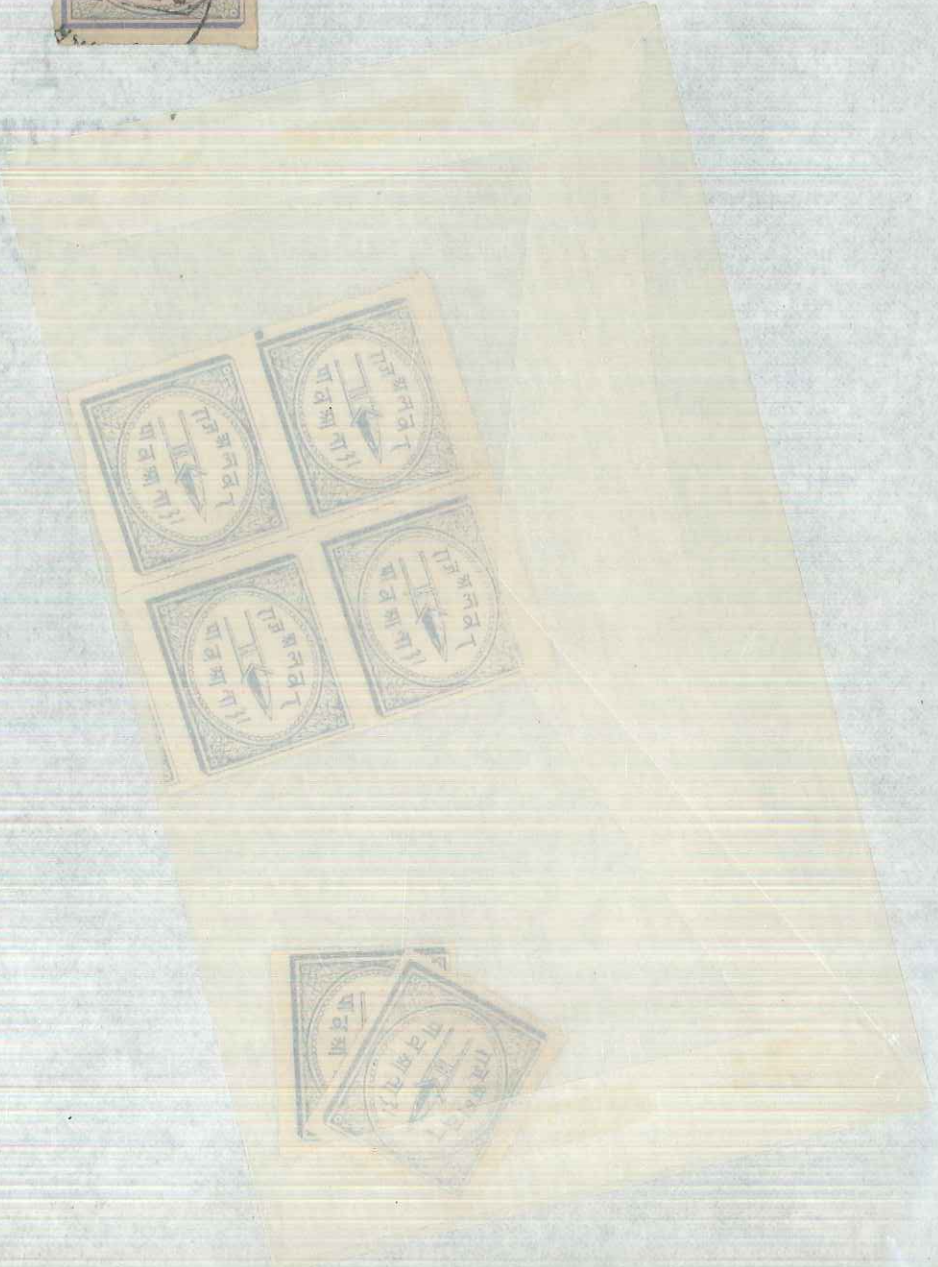
