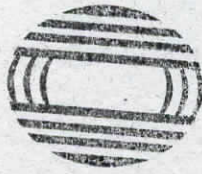
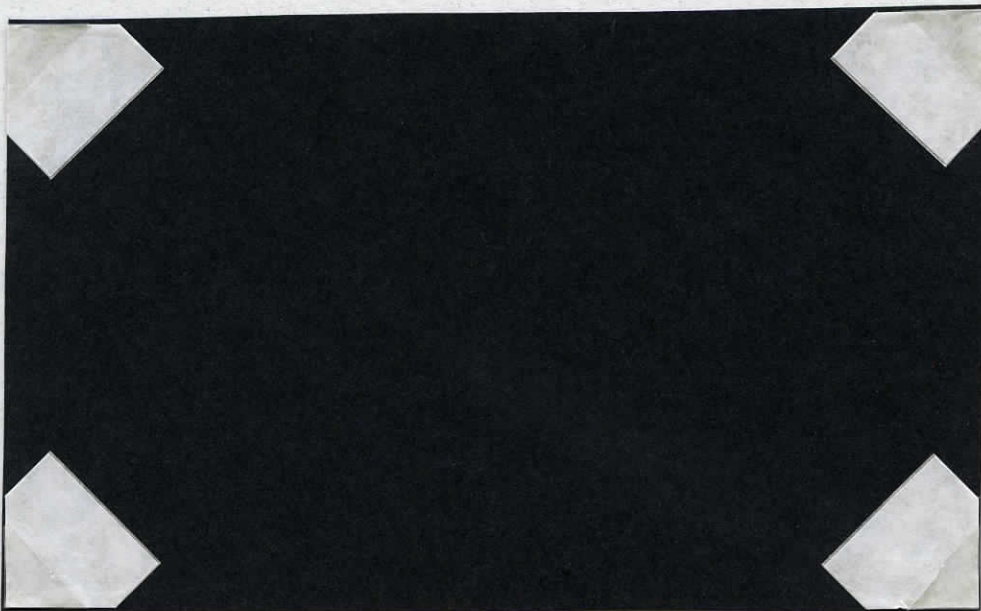

The 1 Shilling 4d Rate
Port Louis to Bushire, Persia

1859 June 30th : Entire Letter, (verso) struck with the double circle 'GPO/MAURITIUS' despatch d/stamp for 'JU-30-1859'.



E. L. franked with a combination of two Single (1859 March) Q.V. 2d blue Lapirot issues/Intermediate Impression/positions 6 & 5 and a single 1859-61 imperf 1/- vermillion seated Britannia issue, all struck and tied with the 'blank oval of bars', addressed to M/s 'J. A. Malcolm & J. A. Malcolm'.
On (recto) annotation 'via Egypt & Beyrout' and red crayon '4', accountancy mark showing credit amount due to the British Post-Office.
On (verso) 'ALEXANDRIA AV/1/59' transit c.d.s.

This is the only example recorded to date.
