

## Rural Origination

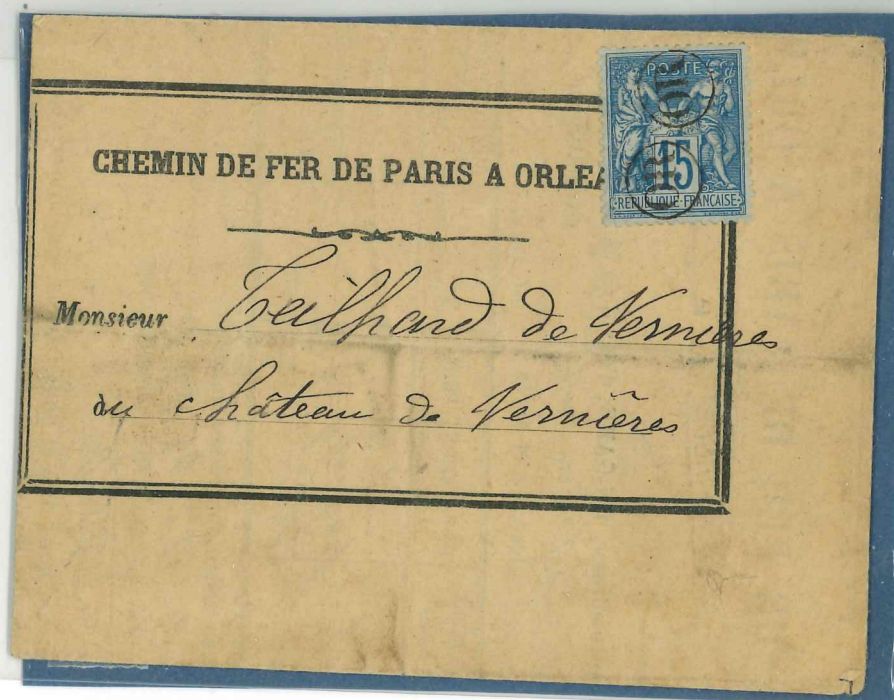
OR in circle = *Origine Rurale* applied to mail handed to rural postman along his circuit route.

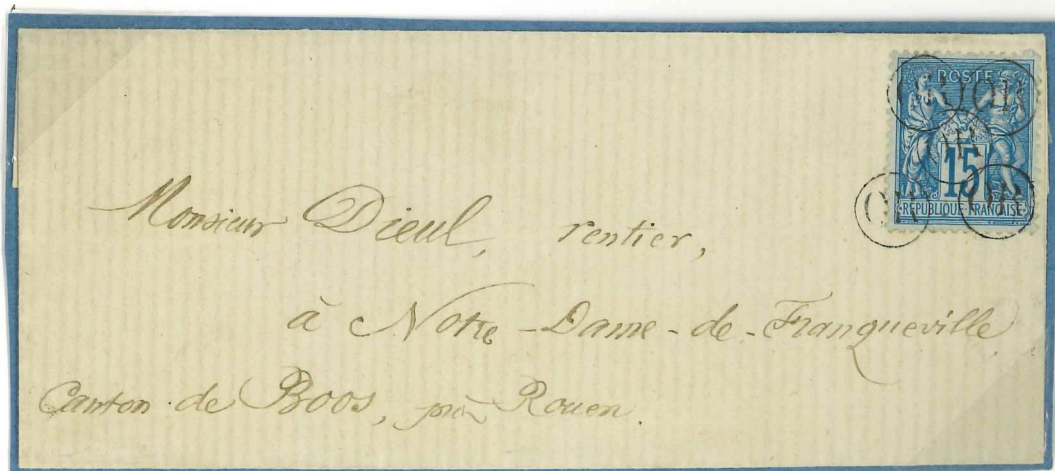

## Miscellaneous Markings and Usages

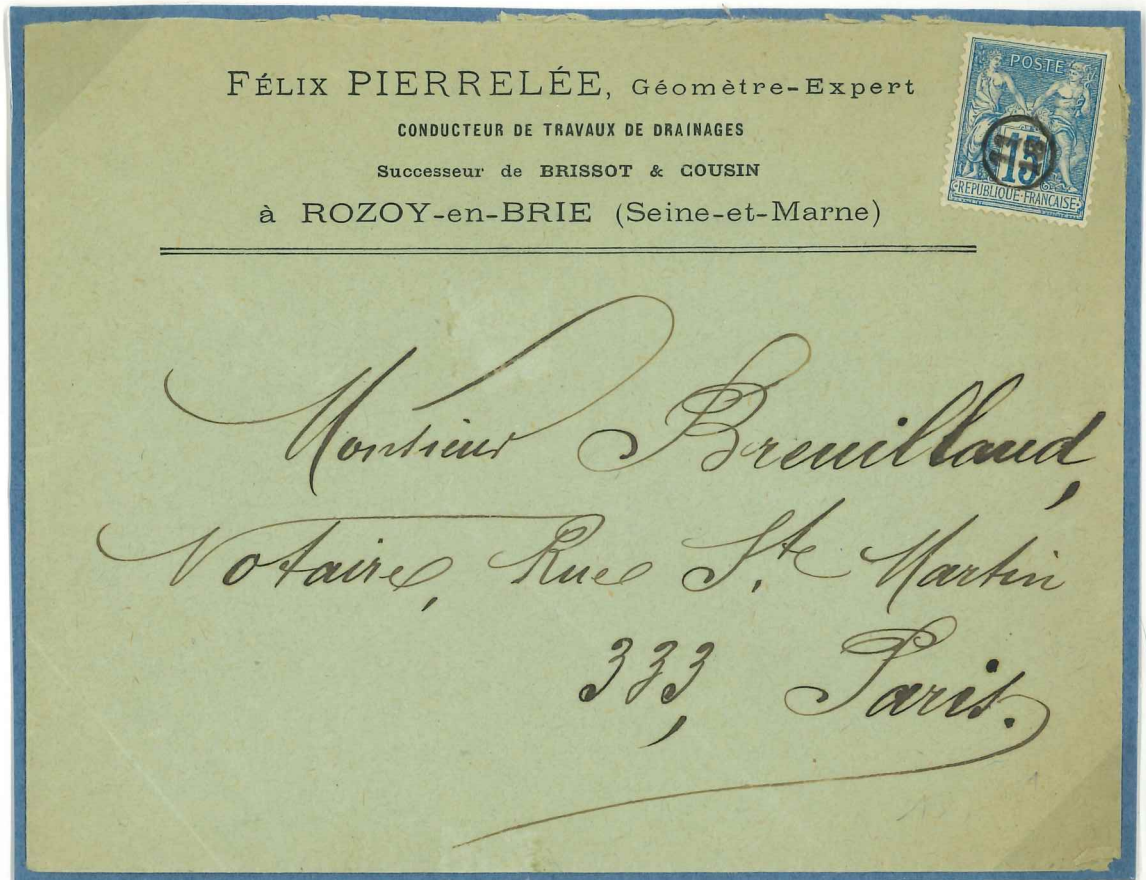
### Paris carrier markings (*cachets de facteurs*)

To indicate personal or box pickup, problems regarding delivery, or simply to cancel a stamp along the route or at destination.
