


1927-30 BRADBURY WILKINSON ARCHIVE FILE COPIES

1/- Gnu: Six marginal blocks of four showing penciled PRINTING DATES and ORDER NUMBERS. Unused and without gum. The blocks are from the three major groups by perforation (Perf 14, 14 x 13½ down & 14 x 13½ up). Interestingly the earliest printing date is apparently five months before the March 1927 recorded in the Union Handbook. Ex-Bradbury Wilkinson Archives.




SG 36 and 36a. Issues 1-4. 1 Shilling Brown and Blue Shades Wmk multiple Springbok's Head

The design is of the two Gnus from the Natal coat of arms in a frame composed largely of flowers. Short lines (A) project to the right from the top of the curved scroll under "S" on the left, and (B) on the right the shading below the last "A" of "AF-RICA"/"AFRIKA" covers less of the flower below it than on the later rotogravure printings. There were two issues of the 1/stamp: the first appeared with perforations of Groups I and II, whereas the second, from Plates 2 and 2x, have perforations of Groups II and III. There were four printings in all.
