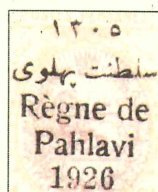


Règne de Pahlavi

In May 1926, the Encshedé Firm in Holland was contracted to overprint the 1909 Coat of Arms issue with "Règne de Pahlavi 1926" overprint.



These stamps were used until and even after May 1927, when the first Portrait Reza Shah stamps became available.



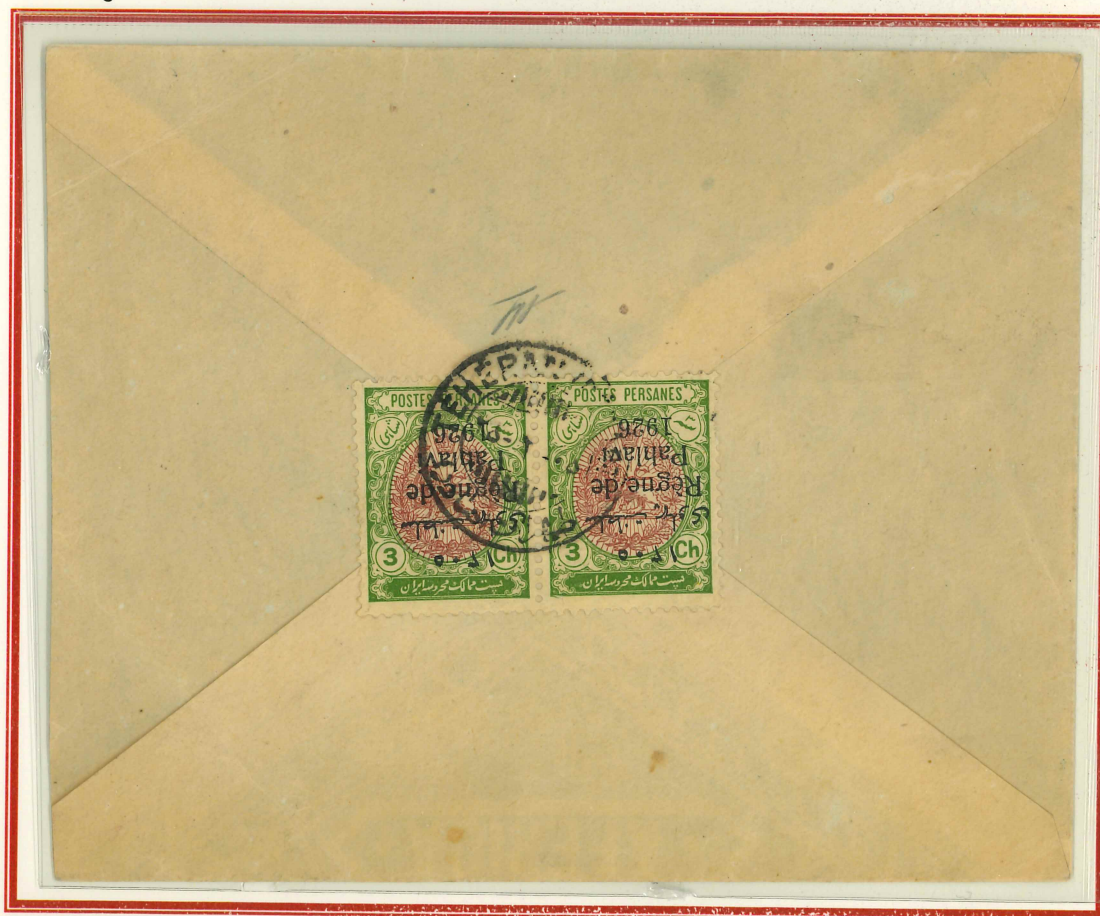
Above – 26 May 1926

on cover front.



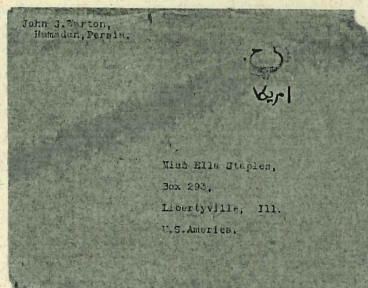
One of very earliest

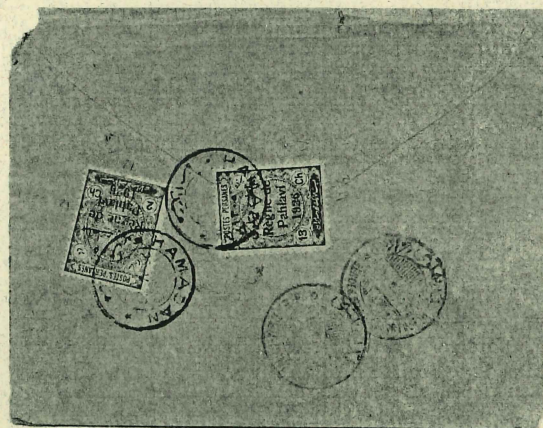
