

And I remembered you because Mr. Johnson told me about you and I have seen out of your Letter which you have sent to my brother I have seen it great many times. Mr. Johnson explained to me about your country, and he says there are good many Christians, their land is little land, there are good many churches and there are good many preachers and Schools. I will be glad when I see our people like America, there are good pious men who fear God and love him and walk in his commandments. We pray God that he may send his holy spirit to our people, that they may learn his way and walk in his commandments and love their God with all their heart and with all their souls. To pray God that he may pour out his spirit upon them that they may be his people. I hope God is now in the Seminary, there are some boys

in their bad actions they have become good after so I don't know I cannot search their heart and heart seem to me good Christians.


