1890 "One Cent" Provisionals

On 15 July 1890 the \$1-\$4 values of the "Inland Revenue" issue were released bearing a red surcharge of "One Cent" and two lines over the original value. This was primarily to use up the large quantity of these Dollar values which were not needed for postal purposes, and had become invalid as revenues.
