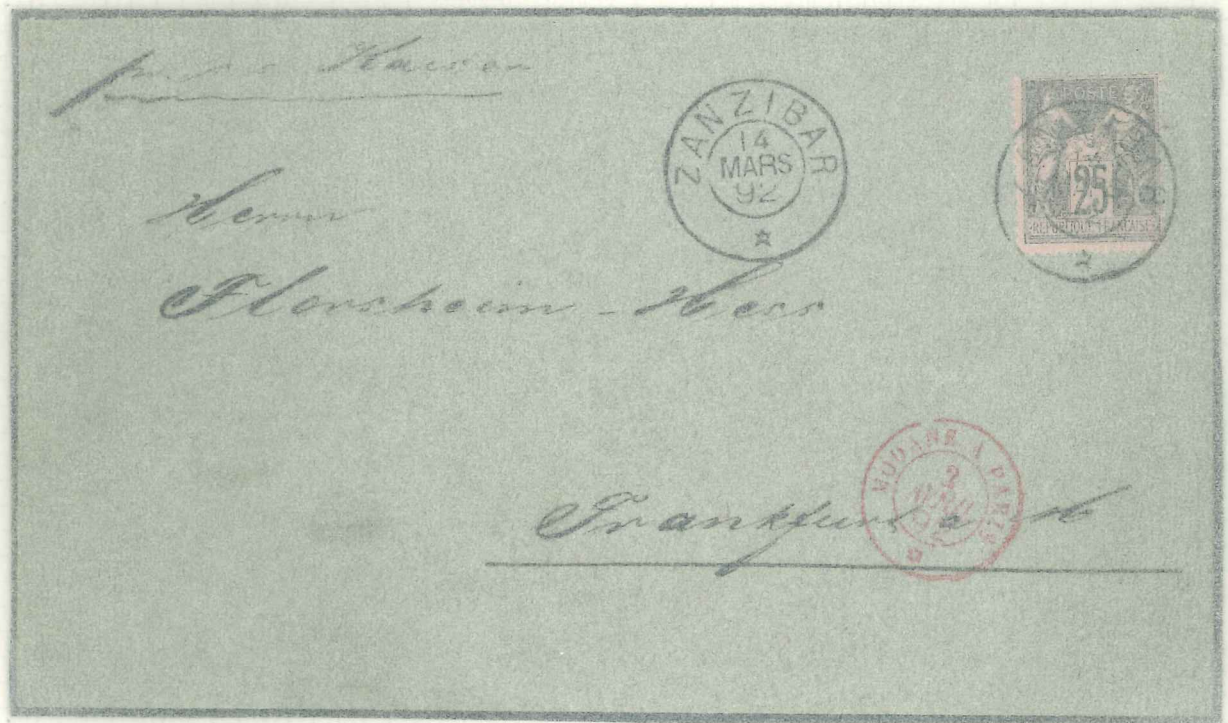

A. French Post Office was opened at Zanzibar in 1889. Until 1894
unoverprinted French stamps were used.

Postmarked Zanzibar, 14 March 1892

Modane a Paris transit, 2 April. Frankfurt arrival backstamp 3 April

Marked 'Per S.S.Kaiser'

Mail from W.Hintzmann, a Zanzibar-based German merchant. Mail from the
same correspondence had previously been sent via the German PO prior to the
latter's closure
