When the sender didn't paste the 15c stamp at 22-23 or 24 Mai 1928, the post-officer put the postage due stamp with the double tariff on the mail and the addressee had to pay!

Villages got the small number of stamps. When the 15c was sold out, they cut a 30c postage due stamp in two as here: "TRAMAGAL" at 24.MAI.1928

25.MAI.1928 The sender forgot to post-paid the cover with the 15c charge-stamp. He only pasted a 40c Ceres on back, which has fallen off. Part of the cancel "Ribeira de Pena, 23.MAI.1928" is still visible. "GRATIS" in mirror writing can suggest the Post did accept the cover for sending. The cover shows a "T" in circle and by blue pencil "30" as tax indication. Arrival cancel "Chaves, 24.MAI.1928" on back. The addressee accepted the postage due of 30c: "Chaves, 25.MAI.1928".

Foot-note: In spite of the cover is sadly battered, such mail is extremely seldom. Outside some covers from big cities as Porto and Lisboa, it is the only one known cover of a small town (in Northern Portugal, near Spanish frontier).

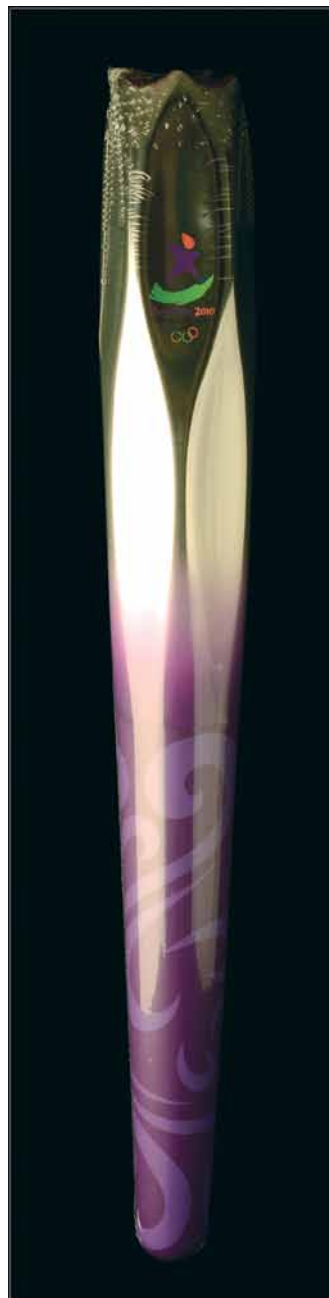

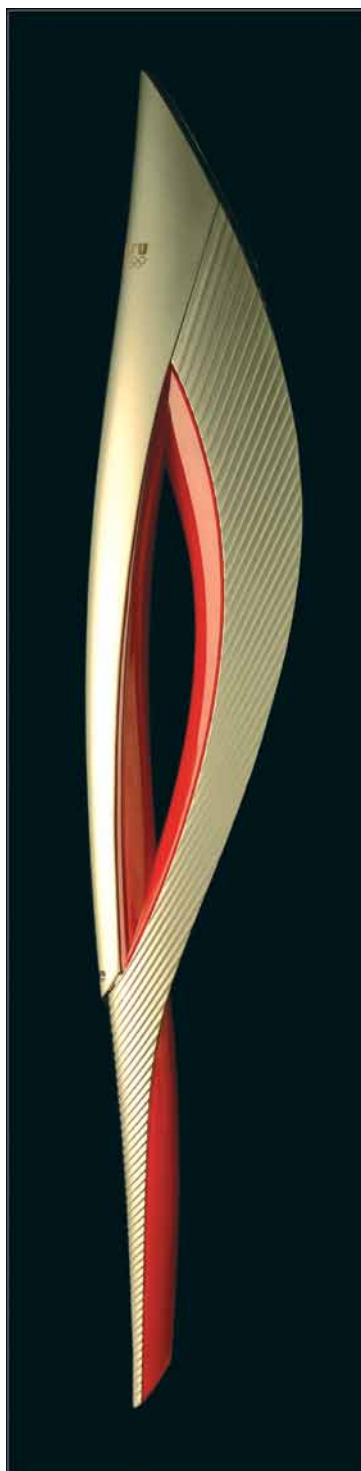
