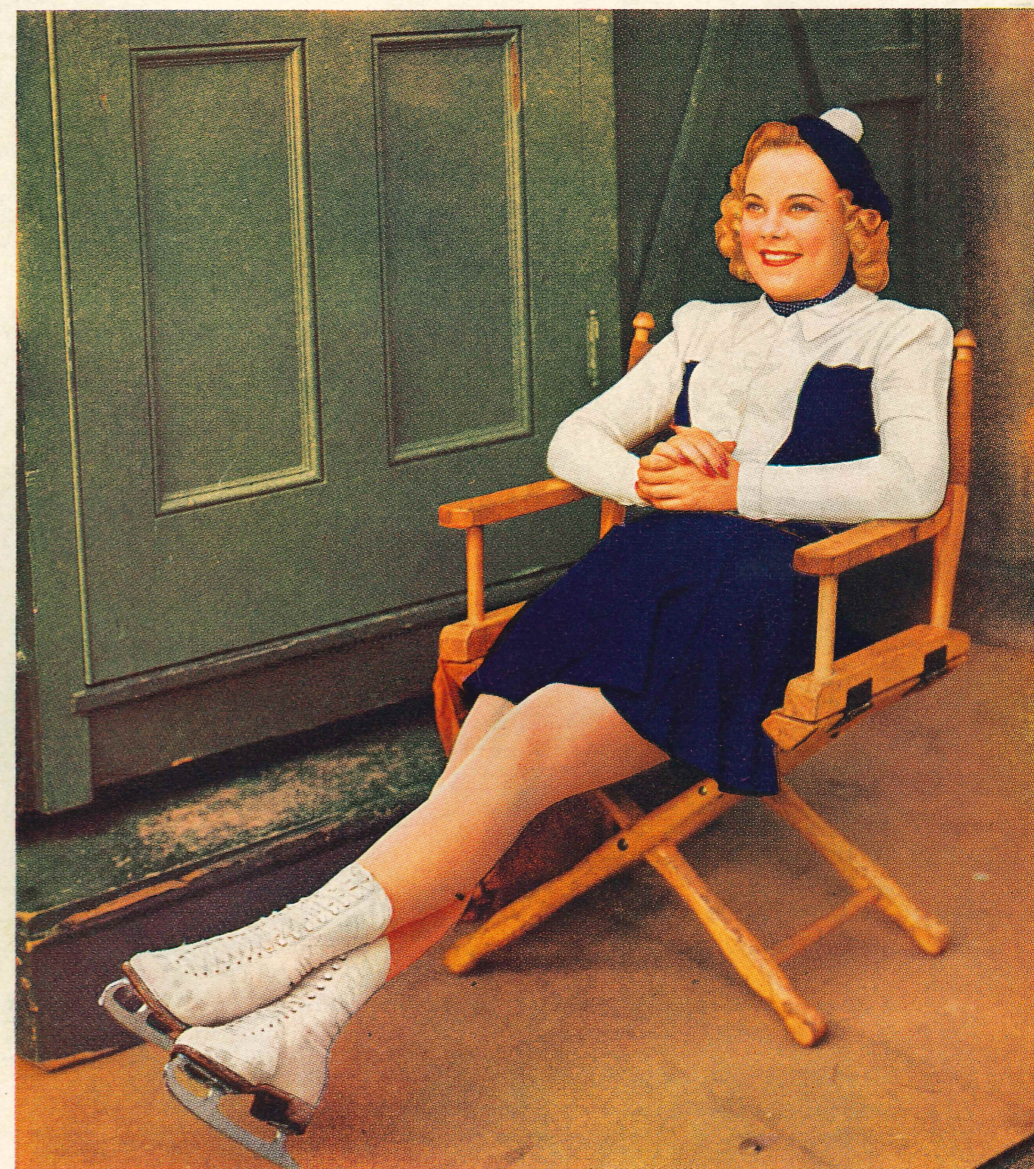

331 ATHLETES SWEAR OATH OF AMATEURISM ADMINISTERED AT OPENING GAMES BY GOVERNOR

Raise Olympic Flag After Parade of Contestants — Colors Dip in Salute

"We swear that we will take part in the Olympic Games in loyal competition, respecting the regulations which govern them and desirous of participating in them in the true spirit of sportsmanship for the honor of our country and for the glory of sport." So reads the Olympic oath of amateurism administered yesterday by Franklin D. Roosevelt, Governor of the State of New York, and sworn to by 331 athletes of 17 nations at the Olympic stadium immediately preceding the first event on the program of international sport.

Jack Shea, one of America's greatest skaters, was chosen by Gustavus Kirby to represent the Olympic contestants in receiving the oath, the assembled contestants grouped in the background raising their right hands in acceptance of the conditions and promise conveyed in the oath of the true sportsman.

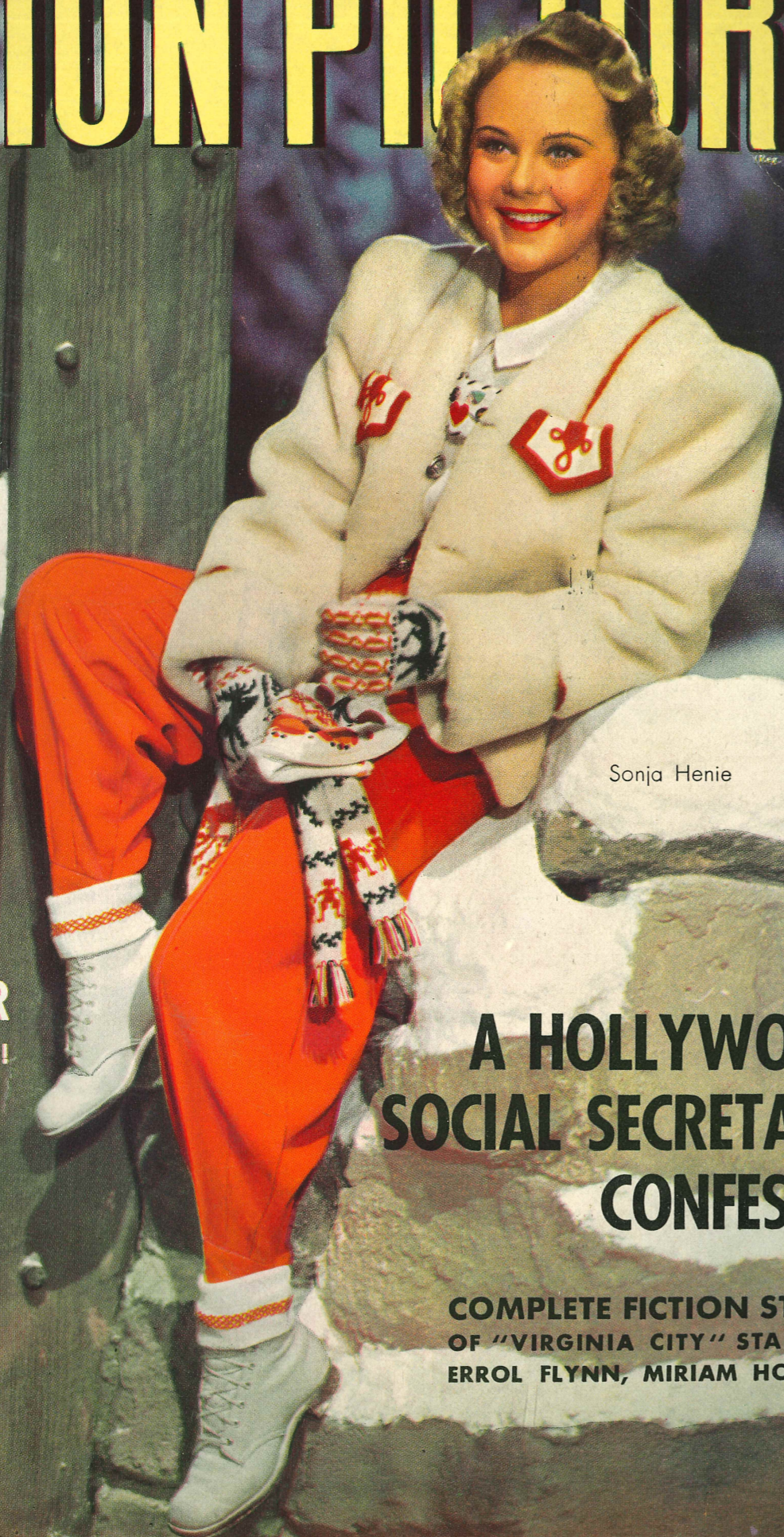
