KASHGAR

Kashgar is in the southwestern part of Sinkiang in the center of an oasis. It is the terminal of roads leading westwards to Russian Turkestan, and southwards to Afghanistan and India across the passes of the Pamir Mountains. The Chinese only restored their rule here in 1878. A Russian consulate was opened in Kashgar in the 1860's. In the early 1900's it had a guard of 100 Cossacks and the Russian community numbered around 2500 persons.

The Russian Post Office here opened sometime between 1902 and 1907. Kashgar cancellations remain rare until the outbreak of the First World War. After this time they are met with in larger quantities. Evidently, the war years witnessed a large increase in postal traffic, due to massive purchases of goods by the Russian armies. The Kashgar office exclusively used Russian stamps and operated until October 1920.


