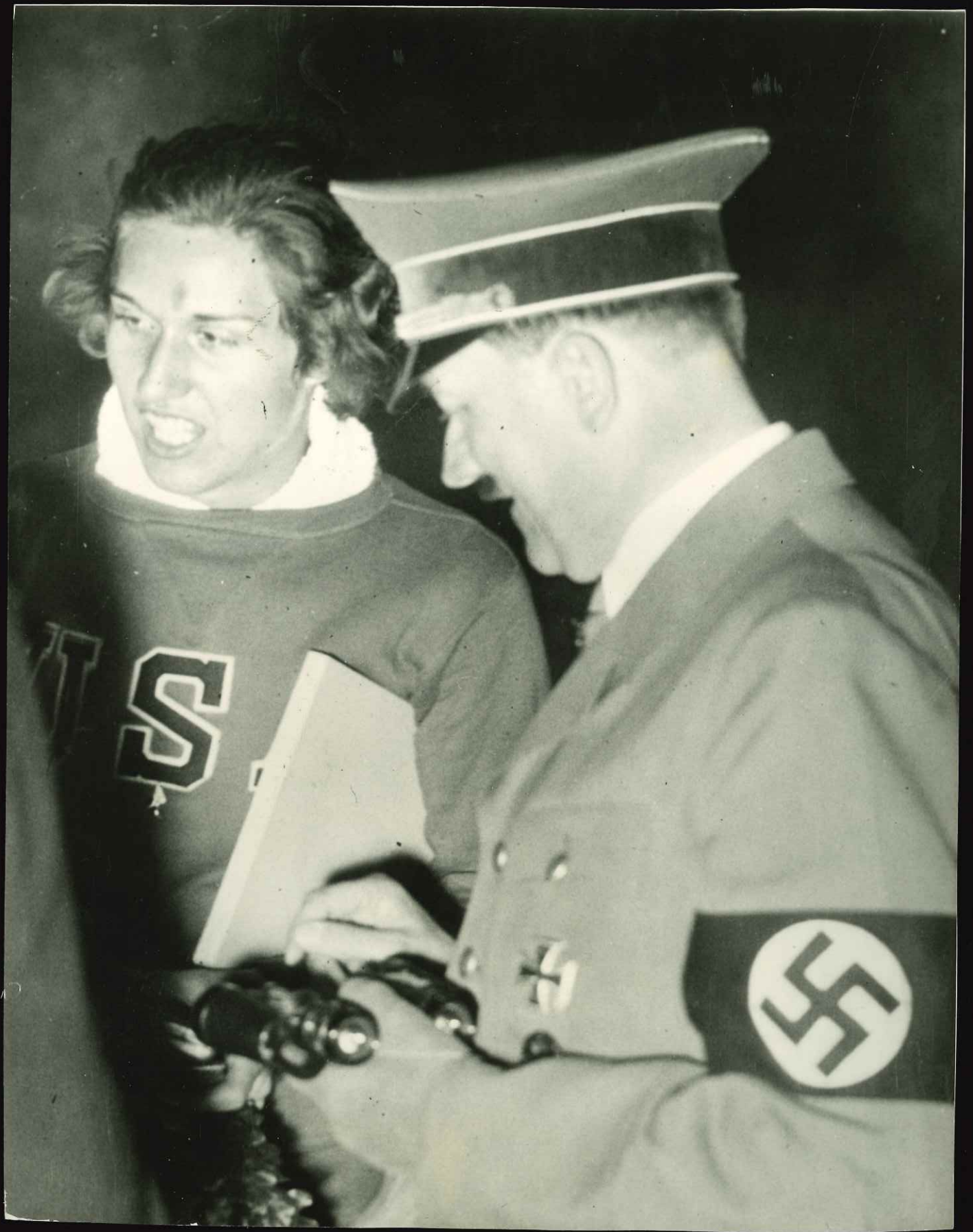

G 3967 - BOCHUM, Germany - To ring in the Eleventh World Olympics which will take place in Germany 1936 a special bell is being cast which will bear the inscription "I call the Youth of the World". This job has appropriately been given to the world's oldest steel foundry, the Bochum Company for Cast-Steel Manufacture. This job will cover about three months and forms are being prepared now.

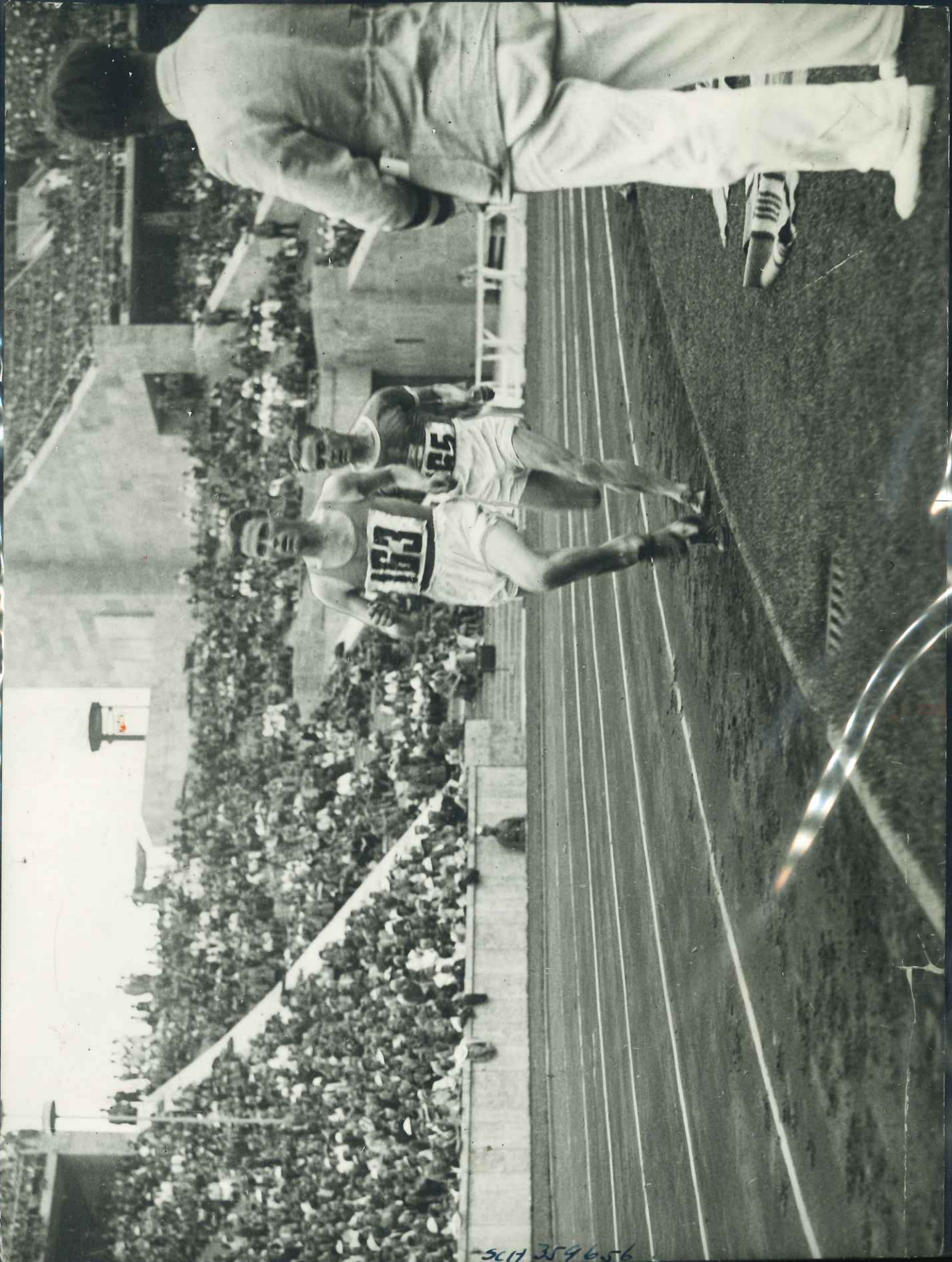

UNION BARGE CLUB, THE ONLY OTHER ENTRANT IN THE RACE.

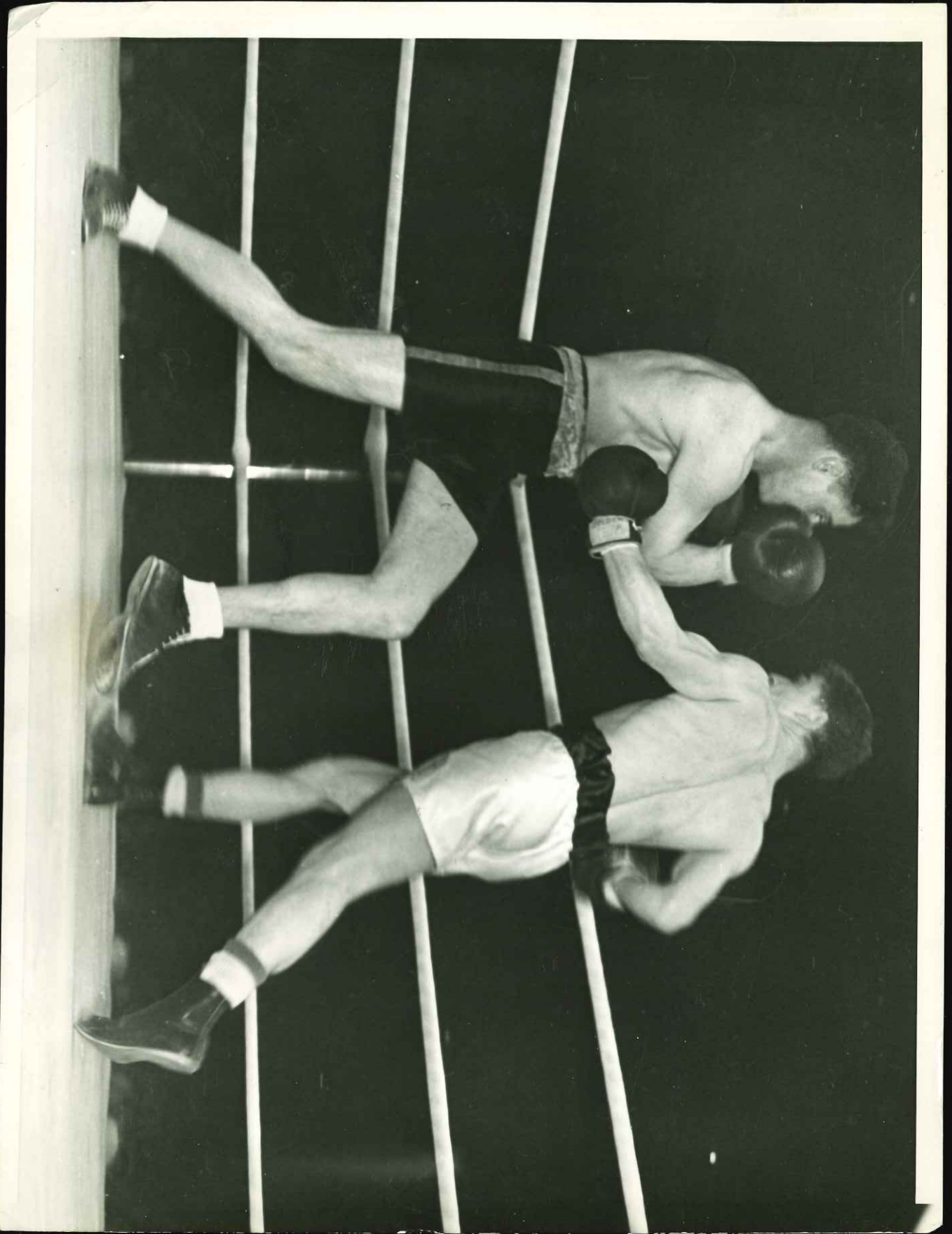


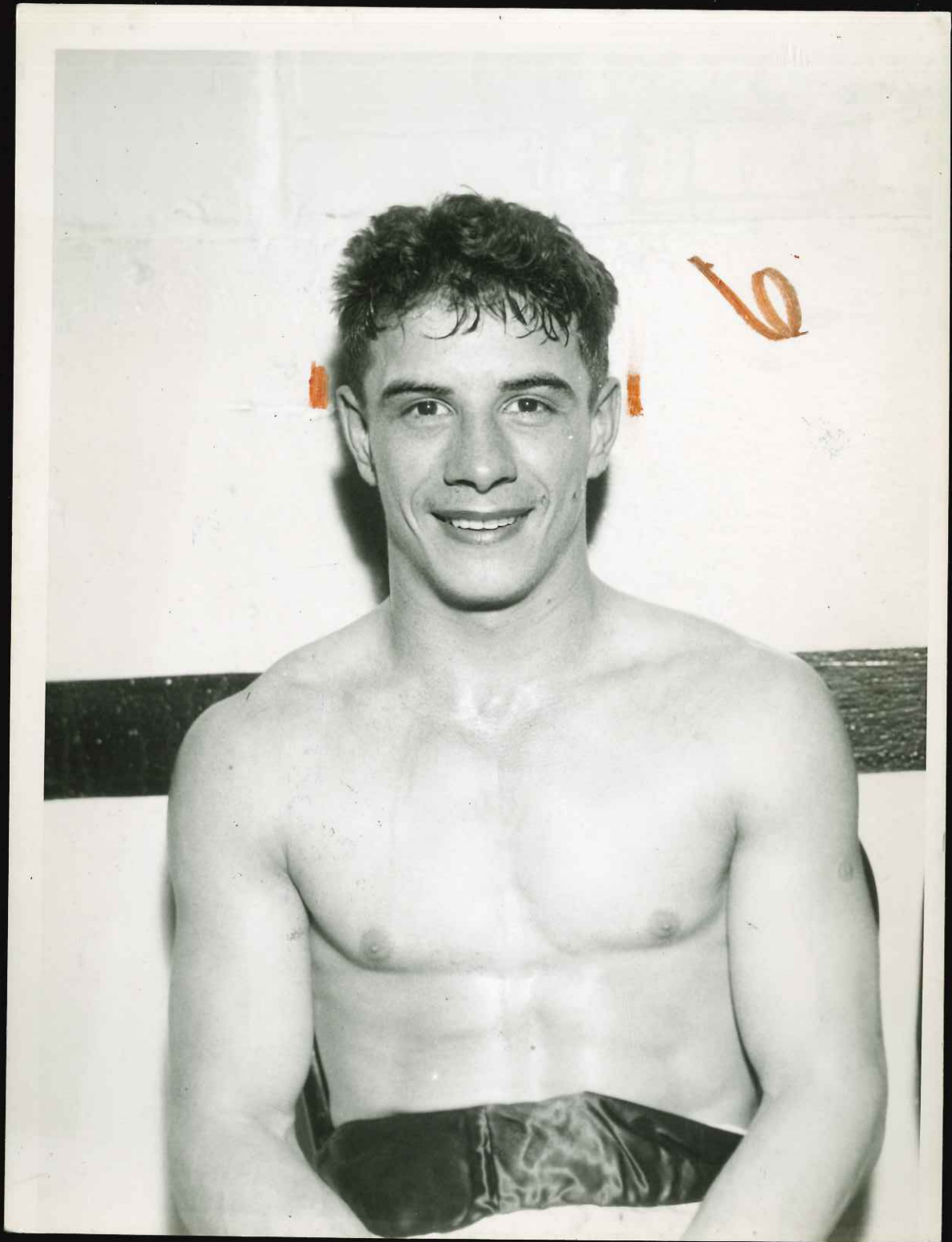

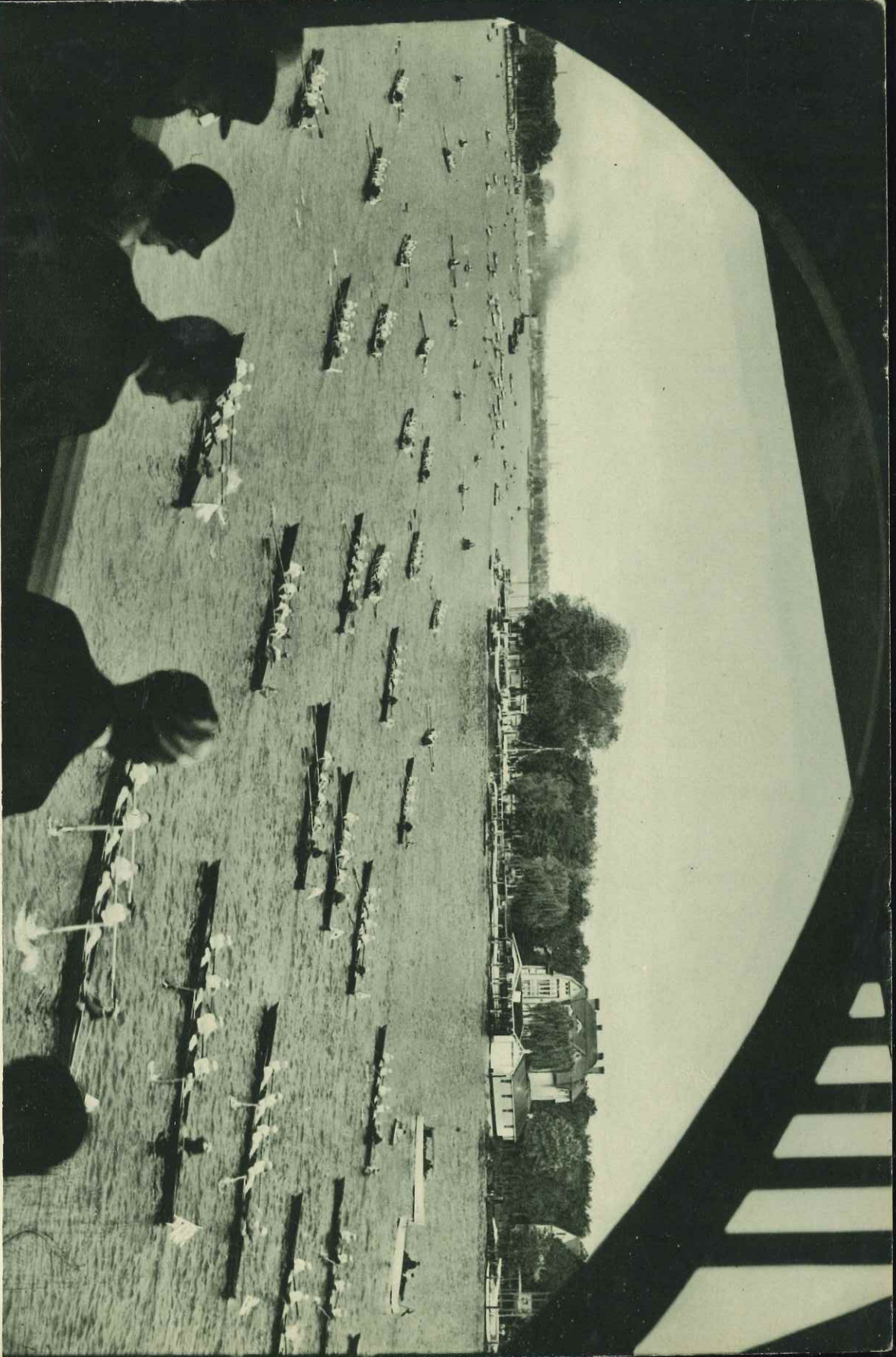
