1879, Second printing

This second printing is printed on different paper than the first and transitional printings but printed from the same printingplates.

The perforation was performed on different perforation machines resulting in a number of perforation varieties:

12 (regular), 12 (irregular), 12 $\frac{1}{2}$, 12 $\frac{3}{4}$, 13 and mixed perforations.



All values line perforation 12 irregular without 25 Novcic. This irregular perforation better known as Montenegro-perforation is a result of a damaged perforation machine.

This second printing is printed on different paper than the first and transitional printings but printed from the same printingplates.

The perforation was performed on different perforation machines resulting in a number of perforation varieties:

12 (regular), 12 (irregular), 12 $\frac{1}{2}$, 12 $\frac{3}{4}$, 13 and mixed perforations.

1890, Third printing

This third printing is printed on stiff paper which resulted in a characteristic unsharp perforation. Colours are always fresh and vary distinctively from the later fourth and fifth printings. The margins between the stamps is Ca. 2 mm.

Early 1893, Fourth printing. All values in line perforation 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 11 $\frac{1}{2}$. The 2 Novcic and 7 Novcic also exist in the rare line perforation 11. This fourth printing shows characteristic 3 mm broad margins between the stamps and has distinct dull colors which have a different UV-reaction than the other prints.

Early 1893, Fourth printing. All values in line perforation 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 11 $\frac{1}{2}$. The 2 Novcic and 7 Novcic also exist in the rare line perforation 11. 


