The Queen's Head issue

By mid 1897, the demand for postal services in the Protectorate had grown to a point where a more structured arrangement was needed than that provided by the CMS missionaries. An order for a series bearing the Queen's head was therefore placed with De La Rue on 21 December. It took until July the following year to agree on the design. The stamps were finally delivered and placed on sale in November.

Uganda did not join the UPU until the posts were amalgamated with those of East Africa in 1901. Specimen examples were nonetheless prepared and sent to Berne for distribution.
