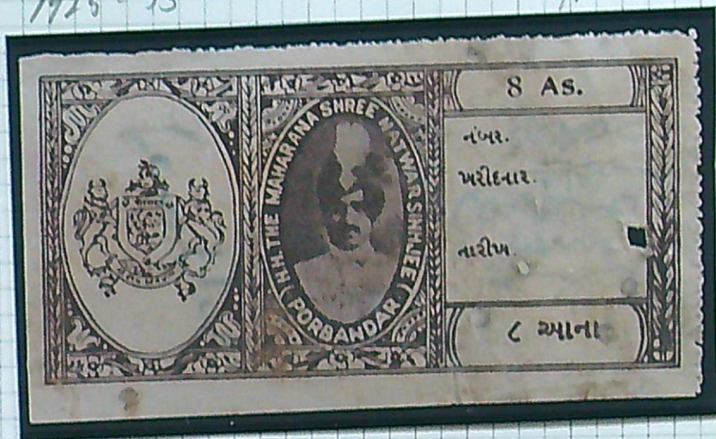
Rajasthan, Greater Union of: This was a 1947 union of 14 Indian states including the stamp-issuing Feudatory States of Bundi (q.v.), Jaipur (q.v.), and Kishangarh (q.v.).  
Stamps of the three states were overprinted for use within the union, although each state reportedly continued to maintain its own postal facilities separately.  
The Republic of India (q.v.) took over postal services in 1950, and the area now uses Indian stamps.
