22 May 1902 triple rate registered cover to the UK franked by both the overprinted values. Registration mark applied in Mombasa since these handstamps were not then available in Uganda. Mombasa transit and London arrival stamps on reverse.

Two 1902 single rate covers to addresses in the London area; one from Archdeacon Walker, the other probably in the hand of Noran Playfair, a military officer in Uganda at the time
