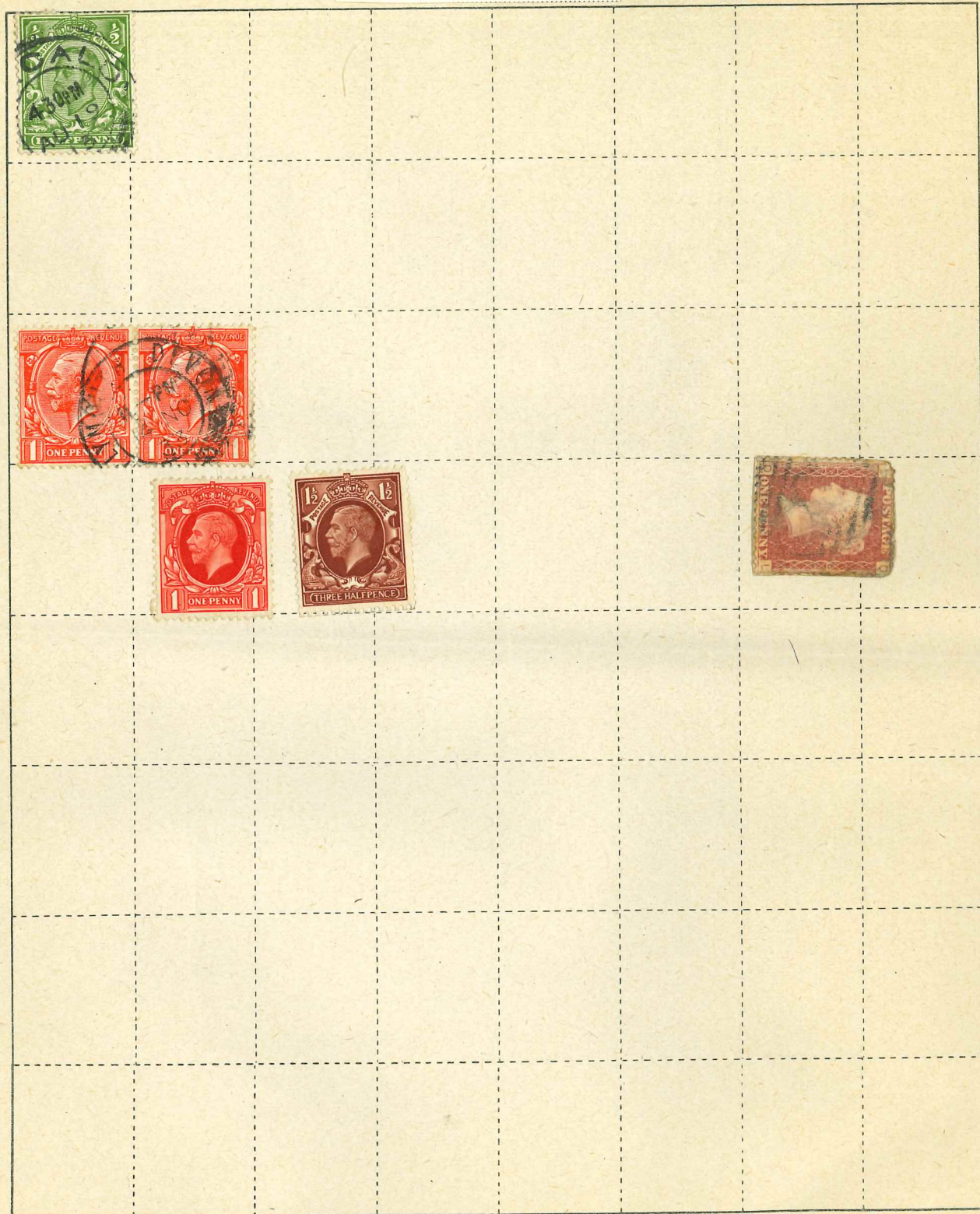

GREAT BRITAIN. Compared with other influential countries, Great Britain, consisting of England, Wales, Scotland and North Ireland, is small, but her power is immense. Her colonies lie in every quarter of the globe and form a great commonwealth of nations. Canada, Australia, South Africa and New Zealand govern themselves, but they all look to Great Britain to protect their interests. Britain is a great commercial country, noted for shipbuilding, coal mining, cotton and wool weaving, machinery manufacture, motor-cars and agriculture. Her mercantile fleet maintains a tremendous overseas trade. London, the capital, is the largest city in the world.
