

ERRORS & VARIETIES

25 October 1965 25th Anniversary of United Nations and International Co-operation Year 3d

Details :15 x 14 perforation , gum Arabic, chalk-surfaced paper, multiple crowns watermark; no phosphor or three bands applied in photogravure ; designed by Jeffrey Mathews ; printed photogravure by Harrison in sheets (6 x 20 x 2 panes) ; 50,598,720 non-phosphor and 4,488,240 phosphor copies sold.

Colours and Plates /Cylinders

Cylinder numbers located in the left margin of sheets by column 1, row 19 ; traffic lights in the right margin by column 6, row 19:

Black-yellow-orange-light blue

1A-1B-1C (dot and no dot, non phosphor and phosphor)

Notes : The stamp was issued with and without phosphor.



VARIETY– 3d Major misperforation causing double perforation at foot of block of six with traffic lights boxed in the margin.



VARIETY– 3 d R 19/3 SG 681b Lake in Russia. Both Ordinary (Right) and Phosphor (Left) versions shown in blocks of 4.
