NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC.

General Post Office,  
8th May 1858.

The Postmaster-General having been pleased to sanction the introduction of Postage Stamps for the prepayment of Packet Postage, notice is hereby given that from this date, the Public will be supplied with stamps of the respective value of 1d., 4d. and 6d. on application to the General Post Office, Kingston, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 2.30 p.m.

For the present the use of stamps is restricted to packet correspondence.

Arrangements will be made for supplying the several Postmasters throughout the Island with Postage Stamps as soon as possible.

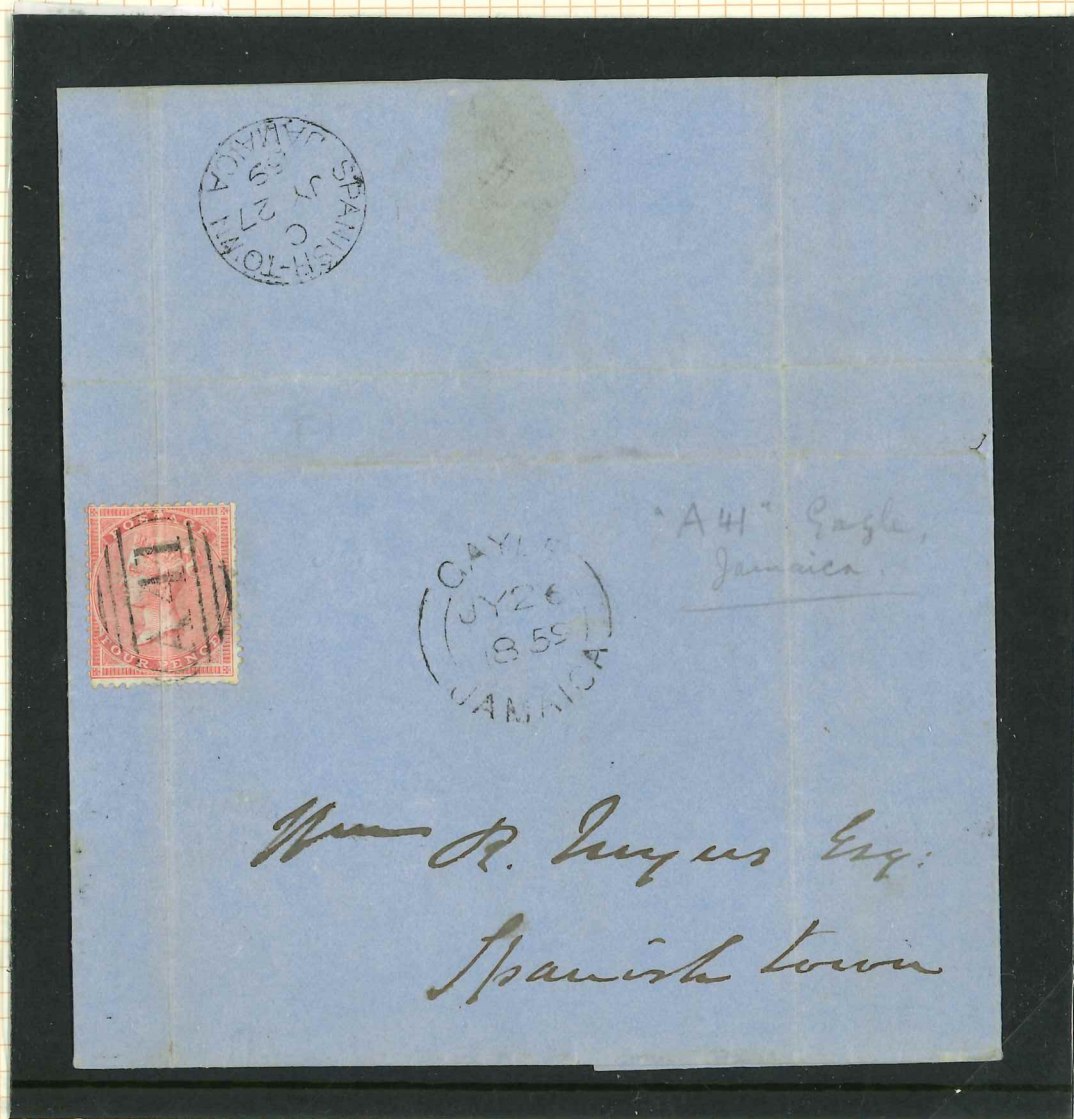

Vertical file fold affecting stamp. Gayle c.d.s. (Jy 26 1859) and Spanish Town  
arrival c.d.s. (Jy 27 1859)

1859 Lilliput "A49" numeral on 6d lilac with wing margin on part local cover addressed to Kingston.

Franked at 8d rate by horizontal pair of GB 1857 4d rose (wing margin at left), neatly

Montego Bay despatch and Kingston arrival (OC 26) backstamps.

Jamaica 1859 : Entire bearing longitudinal pair of 4d. Stamps of Great Britain watermarked Garter (inverted) and perf. 14. It is cancelled 'A75' (S.G./ Z166). It is back-stamped with Savanna-la-Mar for 19-5-59 and with Kingston for 21-5-.
