Stamps to mark  
Development Week

Three commemorative stamps will be printed for the Third Development Week during April.

The Development Board decided on this at its weekly meeting on Saturday. Senator Ali Javdat al-Ayubi, as President of the Development Board, presided.

In all 1,000,000 stamps will be printed. There will be 1,000,000 stamps of one-half denomination, 250,000 of three-fifths and 250,000 of five-fifths.

Each stamp will carry H.M. the King's photo and a view of the Derwent, Kibbik Dam, whose foundation stone will be laid during the Third Development Week, or the Masul Sugar Factory, or a project and rural development programme.

The Masul sugar factory is expected to start production of 250 tons of sugar a month during February. It will be officially opened during the Week.

There will also be 50,000 commemorative post-cards, each carrying a photo of the three commemorative stamps.

Other decisions included one allocating ID 88,000 for the Kibbik Irrigation project, and another allocating ID 48,500 for the fourth six-month budget for the survey work of the lower Taurus and Caucasuses.

The Board also authorized the Ministry of Development's Fifth Technical Section to select land for the Arab Housing Scheme.

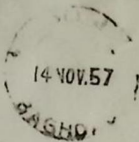

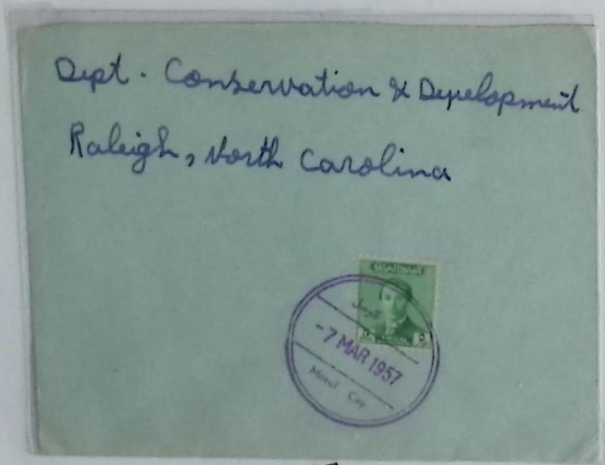

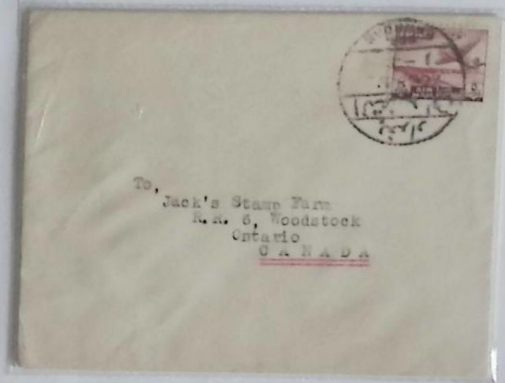
