

1885 (Dec) - 1887. First issue of postage stamps. Overprinted in Cape Town on Cape of Good Hope stamps. Shades exist. In addition to some major varieties there are minor ones caused by misalignment or defective type. Forgeries exist. The genuine overprint measures: 'British' 7-7½mm, 'Bechuanaland' 15¼-15½mm with spacing 3¼-4mm and no full stop at the end.

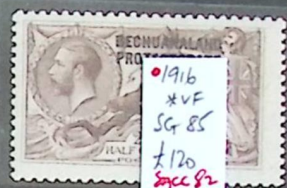

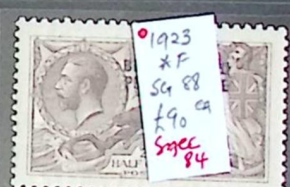

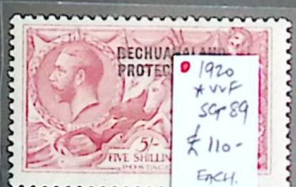
