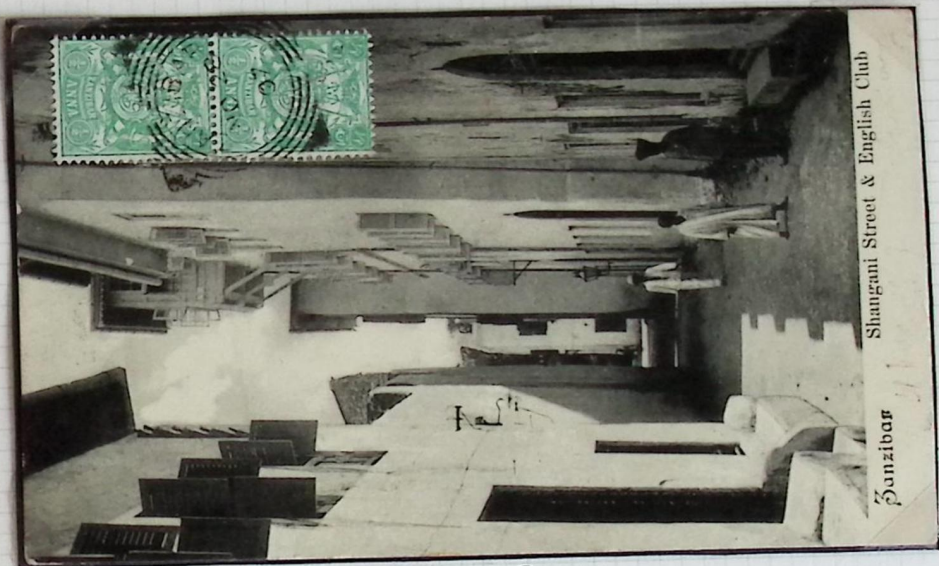

September 1907, presumably official, cover from Pemba to Newcastle, stamped on reverse and postmarked with a 'Pemba-Zanzibar' squared circle

Newcastle-upon-Syne.

The only Post office on Pemba at that time was at Chaki Chaki

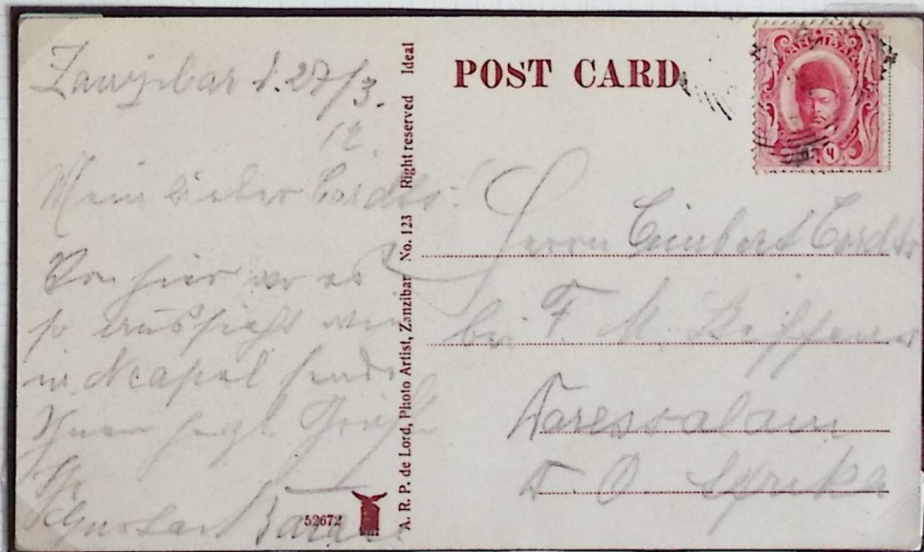

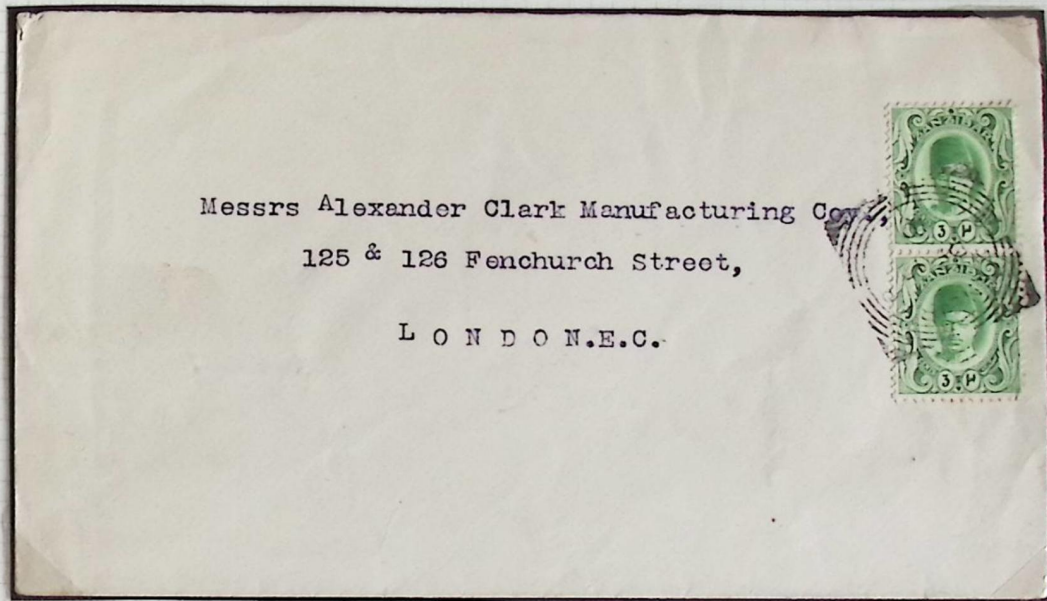

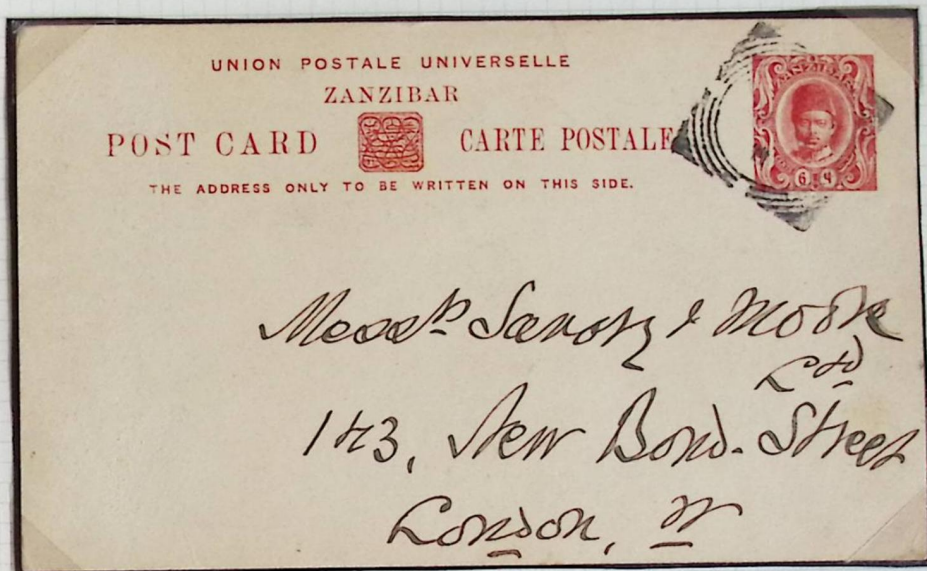

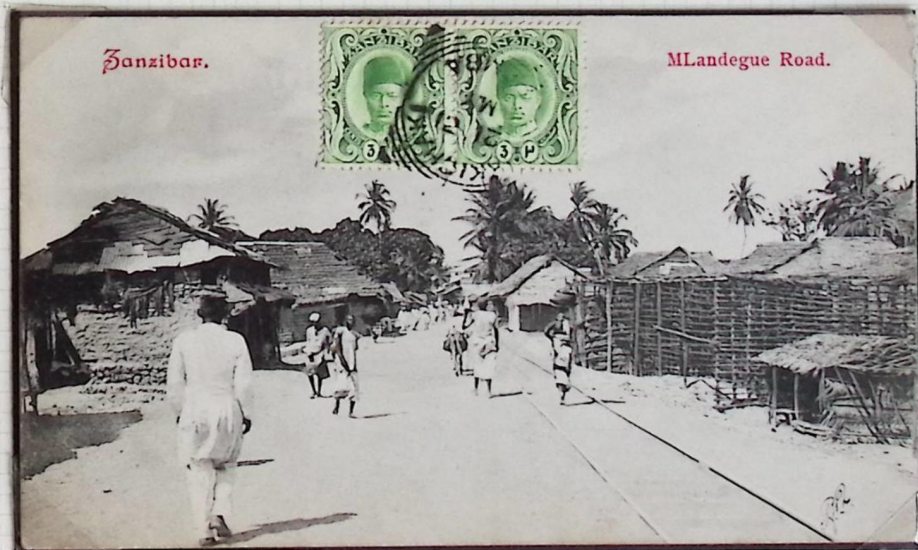
